ORDER PASSED IN OPEN COURT

- 1. Heard Shri A.S Deshpande with Shri S.A Valimbe, learned advocate for the Applicants, Ms Swati Manchekar, learned C.P.O for the Respondents and Shri S.S Dere, learned advocate for Respondents no 8 & 9 in O.A 1084/2019.
- 2. In O.A 1084/2019 and O.A 722/2019, wherein G.R No. Police-1818/File 355/Pol 5A dated 22.4.2019 is challenged by the applicants, private Respondents no 8 & 9 in the said O.A 1084/2019 have raised the



issue of maintainability of the Original Application on the ground of locus of the applicants.

3. In Gajanan B. Bansode & Ors Vs. State of Maharashtra & Ors in Civil Appeal No. 104/2021, filed before the Hon'ble Supreme Court, where the issue of challenge to the same G.R dated 22.4.2019, regarding the promotion to the post of Police Sub Inspector on the basis of Limited Departmental Competitive Examination was challenged. The said case was filed before the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal, Aurangabad Bench. In the said Civil Appeal No. 104/2021 it was found that there are other applicants and challenge is given by different applicants to G.R dated 22.4.2019. Therefore, the Hon'ble Supreme Court in C.A 104/2021 by order dated 5.2.2021, passed the following order:-

"We direct the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal, Aurangabad Bench to decide the pending O.A. within a period of six months from the date of receipt of this Order. The Tribunal will ensure that the additional 636 candidates are given notice of the pending O.A. through the State, to enable them to appear and participate in the proceedings. The Tribunal is further directed to club all pending Original Applications challenging the impunged Government Resolution No.Police-1818/File 355/Pol 5A, and pass a common Judgment in these cases."

- 4. Before the order was passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the above Civil Appeal No. 104/2021, the present Original Applications was filed by the applicants challenging the said G.R dated 22.4.2019 before the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal, Principal Bench at Mumbai. Learned counsel for the private Respondents 8 & 9 and the learned C.P.O for the Respondents have raised the objection of maintainability on account of locus, much earlier to the order dated 5.5.2021 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in C.A 104/2021.
- 5. It is necessary to mention certain factual position in respect of functioning of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal, Aurangabad

bench. The Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal, Aurangabad Bench was not functional from 5.11.2020 due to retirement of all the Members. Thus, when the order dated 5.2.2021 was passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal, Aurangabad Bench was not functional. The said order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court was received by the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal, Principal Bench, at Mumbai. The Maharashtra Administrative was taking some matters by Video Conference and also by entertaining physical hearing, if the matters are mentioned and brought by learned counsel, Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal, Aurangabad Bench, with a view to make the Tribunal run and make it functional so that the Aurangabad bench will not be standstill and the litigants of the said region should get access to justice, especially in urgent matters. Hence, it was found proper and appropriate by the M.A.T, Principal Bench, Mumbai to take up all the matters and since the present matter was made time bound by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the matters which were pending at M.A.T, Aurangabad Bench, the counsel were allowed to mention at M.A.T, Principal Bench. Certain orders in respect of service of notice and filing of affidavit in reply were passed with a view to make matters ready.

- 6. In between, the orders of appointment of Member (J) & Member (A) at Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal, Aurangabad Bench were issued by the Government of India and initially the Single Bench started functioning at M.A.T, Aurangabad from 2.5.2021 and thereafter the Division Bench at M.A.T, Aurangabad is now in operation from 1.6.2021. Hence, the matter where the Government Resolution No.Police-1818/File 355/Pol 5A dated 22.4.2019 is challenged, are transferred to M.A.T, Aurangabad, as the Principal Bench was entertaining these matters in interregnum period.
- 7. Earlier argument on the point of maintainability of the present O.A, challenging the said G.R dated 22.4.2019 was initially heard. However, due to Covid-19 Pandemic, it could not be heard fully. On 3.6.2021, Mr Valimbe, learned counsel for the applicants was asked to go on with the matter and he stated that this matter is to be transferred to



M.A.T, Aurangabad along with O.A 722/2019, in view of the order dated 5.2.201 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in C.A 104/2021. However, Mr Dere, learned counsel for private Respondents no 8 & 9 has raised the objection of maintainability on account of locus. Mr Valimbe, learned counsel for the applicants submitted that he will consider this point whether the applicants have locus or not and will make the statement on next date. Therefore, the matter is fixed today for making statement whether the applicants have locus or not. During the course of hearing, the matter was narrowed down to whether the applicants are age barred or not and whether they have any locus. Mr Valimbe stated that he will take instructions on this point and make statement accordingly whether the applicants are age barred or not and have any locus.

- 8. However, today Mr A.S Deshpande, learned counsel with Mr Valimble appeared for the applicants. Learned counsel Mr Deshpande, has submitted that he does not want to argue on the point of locus, but he said that this matter is to be transferred to M.A.T, Aurangabad in view of the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 5.2.2021 in C.A 104/2021. He read over para 21 of the said order. We also read that para 21 again and again along with Mr. Deshpande.
- 9. Mr Deshpande, learned counsel for the applicants submitted that the Hon'ble Supreme Court has directed the Tribunal to club all the pending Original Applications challenging the Government Resolution No.Police-1818/File 355/Pol 5A dated 22.4.2019 and pass common judgment in these cases within six months. Therefore, it is mandatory on the part of the M.A.T, Principal Bench, Mumbai to transfer these matters to M.A.T, Aurangabad Bench and all matters in Maharashtra are clubbed at M.A.T, Aurangabad Bench.
- 10. The submissions of learned counsel for the applicants Mr. Deshpande are not convincing as para 21 of the order dated 5.2.2021 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in C.A 104/2021 is to be read in its entirety and in its context. In first portion of the order, direction is given to the



Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal, Aurangabad Bench. However, in the second portion while giving another direction, the Hon'ble Supreme Court has used the word "Tribunal", is further directed to club all the pending Original Applications. Thus we read the Tribunal in context with Aurangabad Bench and it cannot be read as Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal as a whole, were the matters filed by the applicants at M.A.T, Nagpur and so also the Principal Bench. Thus, in the order dated 5.2.2021 in C.A 104/2021, the Hon'ble Supreme Court has given directions to club all the Original Applications which are pending before M.A.T, Aurangabad Bench and decide within six months by a common judgment.

- 11. Thus, the directions given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court cannot be said that the Hon'ble Supreme Court has restored upon territorial jurisdiction of all matters pending at M.A.T, Mumbai, Nagpur and Aurangabad in respect of this issue. The litigants from different regions have filed Original Applications while challenging this particular G.R dated 22.4.2019 depending on the vicinity, the Bench available to them either at Nagpur or Mumbai.
- 12. Hence, the request of learned counsel for the applicants to transfer the present Original Applications to M.A.T, Aurangabad bench is hereby rejected.
- 13. Mover, the matter is part heard. Learned counsel for the applicants to advance the submission on the point of locus.
