- This RA No.1/2017 is filed by the State in OA No.428 of 2016 which was decided by this Tribunal by judgment and order dated 9.11.2016 thereby quashing and setting aside the order dated 6.7.2013 imposing punishment of reduction of 5% in pension on permanent basis. The original applicant had retired on superannuation on 30.6.2012 and DE was initiated against him on 29.3.2010 under Rule 8 of MCS (Discipline & Appeal) Rules, 1979. The DE continued against applicant after his retirement. Order passed in DE was challenged mainly on the ground of breach of Rule 27(1) of MCS (Pension) Rules, 1982 on the ground of competency of the authority who imposed the punishment. As per the case of the State the authority was competent as said Rule 27 was amended as per GR dated 2.6.2003 but however, notification was issued on 18.1.2016. The said notification was not placed before the Division Bench of this Tribunal at the time of hearing of the matter and therefore this Tribunal has taken a legal view that MCS Rules were framed under Article 309 of the Constitution of India and Rule 27 cannot be amended by issuing GR dated 2.6.2003. The Tribunal rightly held that GR was issued under Article 162 of the Constitution however as it is a settled position that Rules framed under Article 309 of the Constitution always prevail over the GR issued under Article 162 of the Constitution. The Tribunal relied on the judgment dated 23.4.2012 of this Tribunal in OA No.701 of 2008 Tanaji Krishna Babar Vs. State of Maharashtra.
- 3. After the judgment dated 9.11.2016 of this Tribunal, the Respondent-State filed RA after two months i.e. on
