- 3. Learned P.O. produces communication dated 16.06.2022 from the Additional Director General of Police sent to Additional Chief Secretary, Home, Maharashtra State and copy forwarded to Mr. Swapnil Borse, Under Secretary wherein it is stated that the officer has informed that inadvertently at the time of D.P.C. meeting the vacancies of four posts as on 01.08.2022 is available, was shown. However in fact there are 5 vacancies as one officer retired on 31.05.2022
- 4. Thus after considering this letter of D.G and facts placed before us by learned Advocate and learned P.O. it appears it is a bonafide mistake of the authority and therefore we request the Additional Chief Secretary, Home Department to do needful at the earliest as the Applicant is going to retire at the end of this year.
- 5. We expect the decision to be taken by 11.07.2022 and corrective measures are to be taken on or before 16.07.2022 to consider the Applicant's case for promotion along with deemed date. Thus considering this we are of the view that it is a bonafide mistake and therefore it is to be corrected immediately and also to be considered while considering the case of the Applicant as per Rules.

- 1. Heard Shri K.R Jagadale, learned advocate for the applicant and Mrs K.S Gaikwad, learned P.O for the Respondents.
- 2. The applicant, who is working as Police Constable, has put in nearly 13 years of service, remained absent for 1206 days from duty on the ground that he was suffering from mental depression. The applicant is compulsorily retired from service on 5.10.2013, in view of the departmental enquiry held against.
- 3. The applicant has challenged the said impugned order dated 5.10.2013 of compulsory retirement, issued by Respondent no. 3 and also the order dated 10.3.2015 passed by Respondent no. 2 confirming the order passed by Respondent no. 3 and also prays that he be reinstated in service to the post of Police Naik forthwith.
- Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that the applicant being mentally disabled is entitled to get the benefits of Section 37 of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995. The applicant has to prove the fact of his mental disability relying on the Medical Certificate dated 14.1.2013, issued by Dr Y.A Matcheswala, Professor of Psychiatry and Hon. Consultant, Grant Medical College, Sir J.J Group of Hospitals, Mumbai. In the said Certificate it is stated that the applicant was taking treatment from the private Psychiatry during the period 1.3.2009 to 1.8.2012. He also relied on the document, i.e. Discharge Card issued by Dr. Matcheswalla wherein he has mentioned about depression and that the applicant took treatment from 1.3.2009 to 1.8.2012 and at present no active psychiatric illness. Fit for duty.
- 5. After hearing the learned counsel for the applicant, we are of the view that the applicant first should prove the fact of his mental disability. After going through the documents, it cannot be proved that Dr Matcheswalla was a Surgeon or Practitioner under whom the applicant was treated when he was under mental depression. These two documents are Certificates of Fitness of the applicant. However, the applicant is required to prove the fact of his mental illness and the percentage of such illness to claim the benefits of Section 37 of of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995.
