The reserved vacancies will be filled up separately from amongst the eligible candidates with benchmark disabilities who are lower in merit than the last candidate in merit list but, otherwise found suitable for

The learned Advocate for the Applicant also referred to para 4 of the G.R. dated 29.05.2019 issued by the G.A.D. from which same clause no.4 has been repeated in the latest G.R. dated 20.04.2023 at Clause No.5.3, which is as follows.

Learned C.P.O further submits that above referred G.R. is only for direct recruitment and not for the Limited Departmental Competitive Examination for promotion. Learned C.P.O. submits that in the G.R. dated 05.07.2021 there is procedure prescribed for direct recruitment in the process of LDCE.

4. It is seen that there is office Memorandum of Central Government accommodating disabled person and allowing them to migrate to open category if at all they qualify. Moreover, in view of Clause No.4 of G.R. dated 29.05.2019 the present O.A. is allowed.

5. Revised final list dated 31.05.2022 should be modified considering the reservation of Physically Handicap Candidates as per the direction issued by the Government of Indian and Government of Maharashtra.

6. This should be done within a period of one month from today.

1. Heard Ms Madhvi Ayyappan, learned advocate for the applicants and Ms Swati Manchekar, learned C.P.O for the Respondents.

2. The applicants are working as Full Time Sports Teachers in the Government Ashram School on contract basis since 2018. They seek protection that they should be continued on the same post till the Original Application is decided.

Learned counsel for the applicants submitted that the Respondent-State has taken decision to fill up the post by out sourcing. However, the applicants have been working continuously for last 4 to 5 years. Learned counsel for the applicants relied on the order of the Hon'ble Bombay High Court dated 9.6.2023 in W.PO 6693/2023, Namdeo T. Dhonnar & Ors Vs. The State of Maharashtra & Ors, wherein the discontinuation or the termination of the Primary Teachers and Secondary Teachers in the Ashram Schools under Tribal Development was challenged. The Hon'ble High Court has specifically mentioned in para 3 of the said order that the Hon'ble High Court has earlier disapproved the process of outsourcing and in case of the Petitioners there is every likelihood that they will be rendered jobless despite having served for 8 to 10 years. The facts in the Writ Petition are similar and as the Hon'ble High Court has held that the device of 'technical breaks' presents an fruitless counter argument and the law does not permit this. Learned counsel for the applicants also relied on the order of this Tribunal dated 16.6.2023 in O.A 463, 464 & 465/2023, G.D Avhad & Ors Vs. The State of Maharashtra & Ors, wherein this Tribunal has granted interim protection to the applicants therein.

Learned C.P.O seeks time to file reply.

5. In view of the above we grant interim relief to the applicants by staying the operation, execution and implementation of G.R dated 16.11.2022 to the extent of decision to fill in the post of Sports Teacher by way of outsourcing in Government Ashram School and further the Respondents are restrained from terminating the services of the applicants pursuant to the G.R dated 16.11.2022.
