- 2. The applicant challenges order dated 8.2.2019 there by rejecting his request for fixing his seniority from Class IV to Class III from 1.12.1986.
- 3. The father of the applicant who was working as Police Head Constable in Police Wireless in the office of Commissioner of Police, Mumbai expired in February 1984. The applicant passed SSC Examination on 24.12.1985. The applicant was appointed on compassionate ground as a Watchman on 25.11.1986 in Group D. He came to be promoted as Junior Clerk, Class-III on 30.11.1989 and as a Senior Clerk on 13.4.2012. The applicant his representation dated 6.6.2013 for date of appointment as Junior Clerk which is 1.12.1989 and should be given as 1.12.1986 as the date on which applicant was appointed as Watchman which was subsequently changed as Police Guard.
- 4. Ld. Advocate for the applicant refers to GR dated 26.5.1987. The applicant filed OA No.810/2015 for pay fixation which was decided on 1.12.2015. Thereafter he consistently followed the matter with the department. However, on 22.2.2017 the Commissioner of Police informed him that representation for deemed date was rejected. Then the applicant filed OA No.308/2017 challenging objection raised by the Pay Verification Unit regarding pay fixation and this Tribunal by order dated 10.12.2018 directed the applicant to submit representation

along with necessary documents to the respondents within two weeks. Pursuant to order dated 10.12.2018 in OA No.308/2017 he submitted representation for deemed ate to the Govt. and Govt. by order dated 8.2.2019 rejected his prayer for deemed date of appointment as Junior Clerk.

- 5. Ld. Advocate submits that at the time of appointment on 1.12.1986 applicant was qualified for Class III post and post of Class III was vacant. Though the post of Class III was vacant the applicant was appointed as Class IV employee as Police Guard.
- 6. During the course of arguments, we made the following queries:
- (a) What is the date of application given by the applicant for appointment on compassionate ground.
- (b) Did applicant updated his educational qualification by placing fresh/another application after he cleared the SCC on 24.12.1985 to become eligible for the post of Junior Clerk.
- (c) Did he write immediately to the department as to why he is appointed as Class IV though he was eligible for Class III and whether the appointment is accepted without prejudice or under protest.
