The present O.A. is filed for direction to absorb the Applicant on the establishment of the Superintendent of Police, Jalgaon in view of Inter District Transfer reflected in notification issued by Government on 26.10.2017. He is presently serving an establishment of the Superintendent of Police, Thane (Rural).
- 3. Undisputedly, the Applicant fulfills necessary conditions for Inter District Transfer. He applied for Inter District Transfer on the establishment of Jalgaon on 28.12.2017. In response to it information was called from the Superintendent of Police, Jalgaon about absorption of the Applicant on his establishment. Accordingly, the Superintendent of Police, Jalgaon by communication dated 18.01.2022 communicated his acceptance for absorption of the Applicant from NT (B) category. However, the Applicant is not relieved by the Superintendent of Police, Thane (Rural), and therefore the Applicant has filed this O.A.
- 4. Learned Advocate for the Applicant has pointed out that since the Applicant has fulfilled eligibility criteria for Inter District Transfer and once the Superintendent of Police, Jalgaon has given his consent the Applicant ought to have been relieved and the ground of insufficiency of staff/lack of man power cannot be the ground. He has further pointed out that as per information received by the Applicant under R.T.I, 75 Police Personnel joined the establishment of the Superintendent of Police, Thane (Rural) from 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2022 and against it 40 Police Personnel were relieved in Inter District Transfer.
- 5. Per contra, learned P.O. submits that there is lack of manpower and the Superintendent of Police, Thane is

going to undertake recruitment process which would be completed after three months, and thereafter only the Applicant can be relieved.

- 6. As stated above, the Applicant fulfilled the necessary conditions for Inter District Transfer in terms of notification dated 26.10.2017. One of the conditions is that in a year Inter District Transfer should not exceed 5% In otherwords, there could be of sanctioned strength. Inter District Transfer upto 5% in a year. Whereas, in present case there is nothing on record to establish that 5 % limit is exceeded in 2022. On the contrary, information sought under R.T.I. (Pg 140 & 141 of P.B.) reveals that in the period from June 2021 to 30 June 2022, 55 Police Constable joined the Superintendent of Police, Thane (Rural) establishment by way of Inter District Transfer and 23 Police Constable joined as a new recruitee. Thus, in the said period from June 2021 to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2022, 75 Police Constable have joined the establishment of the Superintendent of Police, Thane. This being so, the ground raised by learned P.O. that there is lack of manpower holds no water. That apart, limit of 5% Inter District Transfer in a year has not crossed. I therefore see no reason for not relieving the Applicant.
- 7. As stated above, the Superintendent of Police, Thane (Rural) is undertaking new recruitment and he will get fresh candidates / additional Police Constable within three months. Therefore if three months' time is granted to relieve no inconvenience or difficulty will cause to the Superintendent of Police, Thane (Rural). The Superintendent of Police, Jalgaon in Affidavit-in-Reply has clearly stated that he is ready to absorb the Applicant on his establishment as and when relieved by the Superintendent of Police, Thane (Rural). O.A. is therefore disposed of in following terms:-
  - A) The Original Application is allowed.
  - B) Respondent No.3 The Superintendent of Police, Thane (Rural) is directed to relieve the Applicant within three months from today.
  - C) Respondent No.4 The Superintendent of Police, Jalgaon shall keep one post of the category which the Applicant belong to vacant for three months.
  - D) No order as to costs.

- 1. Heard Shri K.R Jagdale, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Shri A.J. Chougule, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. The Applicant has challenged suspension order dated 02.05.2022 whereby he is suspended in contemplation of D.E. invoking Rule 4(1) of Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline & Appeal) Rules, 1979.
- 3. Learned Advocate for the Applicant submits that the Applicant is subjected to prolong suspension beyond 90 days without taking review or initiation of D.E., and therefore he is liable to be reinstated with pay and allowances.
- 4. Per Contra, Shri A.J. Chougule has tender order dated 03.10.2022 issued by Respondent whereby suspension is revoked and the Applicant is reinstated in service.
- 5. Thus now the Applicant is reinstated in service. However, learned Advocate for the Applicant raised grievance that his client is not paid subsistence allowance and also claimed pay and allowance after the expiration of 90 days period of suspension is over.
- 6. Hon'ble Supreme Court in (2015) 7 SCC 291 (Ajay Kumar Choudhary Vs. Union of India & Anr.) in Para 21 held as under:-
  - 21. We, therefore, direct that the currency of a suspension order should not extend beyond three months if within this period the memorandum of charges/charge-sheet is not served on the delinquent officer/employee; if the memorandum of charges/charge-sheet is served, a reasoned order must be passed for the extension of the suspension. As in the case in hand, the Government is free to transfer the person concerned to any department in any testitis offices within or outside the State so as to sever any local or personal contact that he may

have and which he may misuse for obstructing the investigation against him. The Government may also prohibit him from contacting any person, or handling records and documents till the stage of his having to prepared his defence. We think this will adequately safeguard the universally recognized principle of human dignity and the right to a speedy trial and shall also preserve the interest of the Government in the prosecution. We recognize that the previous Constitution Benches have been reluctant to quash proceedings on the grounds of delay, and to set time-limits to their duration. However, the imposition of a limit on the period of suspension has not been discussed in prior case law, and would not be contrary to the interests of justice. Furthermore, the direction of the Central Vigilance Commission that pending a criminal investigation, departmental proceedings are to be held in abeyance stands superseded in view of the stand adopted by us."

- 7. Indeed, Government of Maharashtra has also issued circular dated 09.07.2019 instructing the Department to take necessary steps for initiation of D.E. and review within 90 days from the period of suspension.
- 8. Despite aforesaid position the Applicant is subjected to prolong suspension beyond 90 days. In the period of 90 days neither review is taken nor D.E. is initiated and he was subjected to suspension which is totally impermissible in law. Suffice to say, suspension after expiration of 90 days period is totally bad in law.
- 9. In view of above, O.A. is disposed of with following direction.
  - A) Subsistence allowance if not paid, it be paid within two weks from today.
  - B) Suspension beyond 90 days being impermissible in law he is also entitled for pay and allowances after expiration of 90 days.
  - C) Respondents are therefore directed to pay, pay and allowance to the Applicant after expiration period of 90 days till date of reinstatement in service and it be paid within two months from today.
  - D) No order as to costs.

- 6. By Hand delivery, speed post, courier notice to be served and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.
- 7. In case notice is not collected within seven days or service report on affidavit is not filed three days before returnable date, the OA shall be placed on board before the concerned Bench under the caption "For Dismissal" and thereafter on the subsequent date the OA shall stand dismissed.
