Advocate for the Applicant states that the Applicant who was recently appointed to the post of 'Laboratory Scientific Officer' on the Establishment of 'Medical Superintendent, Sub-District Hospital, Karmala, District Solapur' was terminated on 20.9.2024 on the grounds of not possessing 'Internship Certificate' prior to the 'Last Date' for submission of 'Application Form'.

- 4. Ld. PO on the other hand states that the Degree of Bachelors of Paramedical Technology in Laboratory or Bachelor of Science in Paramedical Technology in Laboratory is granted only upon successful completion of 'Internship Period' as per letter dated 28.3.2023 issued by 'MUHS, Nashik'.
- 5. Ld. PO thus informed to obtain information from Public Health Department whether Degree of Bachelors of Paramedical Technology in Laboratory or Bachelor of Science in Paramedical Technology in Laboratory can even be awarded by 'MUHS Nashik' without completion of Internship period and whether it is integral part of 'Academic Curricular'. Or is it a case where Bachelor's Degree of Paramedical Technology in Laboratory or Bachelor of Science in Paramedical Technology in Laboratory can be awarded independently and the 'Internship Certificates' are separately issued by respective 'Colleges'.
- 5. The 'Balance of Convenience' at this stage for the reasons mentioned above lies with the Applicant because of the fact that all the documents of 'Educational Qualification' including about 'Internship Certificate' were required to be diligently verified

before she was appointed to the post of 'Laboratory Scientific Officer'. Hence, Respondent No.3 is informed not to take any action which may result in this Vacant Post of 'Laboratory Scientific Officer' not being available if the Applicant were to be succeed based on interpretation required of 'Educational Qualifications' set out in the Advertisement dated 28.8.2023 which has no mention about the necessity of 'Internship Certificate'.
