- 2. In the present O.A., Applicant stands retired on 31.05.2018 but still his provisional pension and gratuity is withheld.
- 3. Perusal of O.A. reveals that in 2010 the Applicant was suspended by order dated 21.05.2010. He had filed O.A.No.628 of 2010 challenging suspension and delay in conclusion of Departmental Enquiry. The O.A. was disposed of on 22.11.2010 with following order of which paragraph 5 reads as under:-

"Having regard to the afaresaid facts and circumstances, the respondent is directed to complete the entire disciplinary enquiry within a period of two months from today. The respondent-government shall take a decision an the enquiry report within a period of one month thereafter. It is made clear that if at either of the stages that the disciplinary enquiry is not completed within a period of two months or the decision is not taken by the respondent-government within a period of one month thereafter, the aforesaid suspension order dated 21.5.2010 shall stand revoked without any further reference to this Tribunal and the applicant to be given apprapriate posting. With these directions, O.A. stands disposed off accordingly."

As such, though the directions were given to complete Departmental Enquiry within two months still it seems to have been pending.

In view of order passed by this Tribunal suspension was deemed to be revoked and applicant was reinstated in service.

As such facts discloses laxity and negligence on the part of the concerned to complete Departmental Enquiry as well as disregard to the order passed by this Tribunal in D.A.No.628 of 2010 on 22.11.2010.

On the above background, Applicant has sought interim relief in terms of grant of provisional pension as prayed in paragraph 10(a), which is quite just and deserves to be accepted.

8. Respondents are, therefore, directed to release provisional pension according to entitlement of the Applicant within two weeks from today.

9. Respondents are further directed to explain as to why D.E. initiated in 2010-2011 is not completed till date.

10. Respondent No.1 Is directed to file affidavit to explain the delay in completion of D.E., so as to determine as to why Contempt proceedings should not be initiated for willful disobedience of the order, dated 22.11.2010 in D.A.No.628 of 2010.

11. Issue notice returnable on 21.11.2019. Hamdast and steno-copy is granted.
