



In the present O.A., Applicant stands retired on 31.05.2018 but still his provisional pension and gratuity is withheld.</p> <p>3. Perusal of O.A. reveals that in 2010 the Applicant was suspended by order dated 21.05.2010. He had filed O.A.No.628 of 2010 challenging suspension and delay in conclusion of Departmental Enquiry. The O.A. was disposed of on 22.11.2010 with following order of which paragraph 5 reads as under :-</p> <p align="center"><i>"Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the respondent is directed to complete the entire disciplinary enquiry within a period of two months from today. The respondent-government shall take a decision on the enquiry report within a period of one month thereafter. It is made clear that if at either of the stages that the disciplinary enquiry is not completed within a period of two months or the decision is not taken by the respondent-government within a period of one month thereafter, the aforesaid suspension order dated 21.5.2010 shall stand revoked without any further reference to this Tribunal and the applicant to be given appropriate posting. With these directions, O.A. stands disposed off accordingly."</i></p>

The proposed amendment is unnecessary and nothing but abuse of process of law.</p> <p>7. There is no merit in the Misc Application and the same is dismissed.</p> <p>8.
