5. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.

6. Applicants are authorized and directed to serve on Respondent intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A.. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

7. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open. 8. The service may be done by Hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicants are directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.

9. In case notice is not collected within three days or service report on affidavit is not filed 3 days before returnable date, Original Application shall stand dismissed without reference to Tribunal and papers be consigned to record.

10. Heard on Interim relief.

11. Respondents 7 to 160, to be appointed furtherance to Government decision at Exhibit E, page 65, dated 05.03.2018. Respondents be informed that their appointments are made subject to outcome of present O.A..

12. It shall be open to the Government to act for curing the defect/deficiency brought to the notice of Government by applicant, through present O.A. without waiting for adjudication, by taking legal advice well in advance, and before filing of affidavit-in-reply.

13. Steno copy and Hamdast is allowed.

14. Learned P.O. is directed to communicate this order to the Respondents.
