The 'Chief Conservator of Forest (Territorial), Nashik' in 'Memorandum' dated 12.12.2023 has observed that the Options at Sr. No. 8 to 10 given by Applicant which were for transfer to few establishments of 'Social Forestry' could not be done on grounds of lack of administrative jurisdiction of 'Deputy Chief Conservator of Forest (Territorial), East Division Nashik'. Therefore, if the post of 'Forest Guard; at' 'Satana' 'Social Forestry' is still available, then it is directed that as per earlier request of Applicant it be considered now and appropriate decision taken in 'One Week' by 'Chief Conservator of Forest (Territorial), Nashik'. The Applicant had infact shown willingness to work on 'Territorial Posts' of 'Forest Guard' at 'Umrane, Nandori, Rameshwar, Varshi, Kalvan, Aatur, and Nandurtek' which are all in 'Difficult Areas'. The post of 'Forest Guard, at 'Satana' 'Social Forestry' is also in 'Difficult Areas'.

The Chief The 'Chief Conservator of Forest (Territorial), Nashik' with reference to reasons recorded in 'Memorandum' dated 12.12.2023 to further ascertain within 'One Week' if any GAD Circular and G.R. have been issued which directs that transfer of Government Servants under 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005' on posts in areas under 'P.E.S.A. Act, 1996' by kept in abeyance. Thereafter, if Applicant is not given transfer to post of 'Forest Guard' at 'Satana' 'Social Forestry'; then Chief 'Chief Conservator of Forest Territorial), Nashik' to review 'Memorandum' dated 12.12.2023 within 'Two Weeks' and pass appropriate order to transfer Applicant on any 'Vacant Post' of 'Forest Guard' as per his options Sr. No. 1 to 7.
