Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the applicants are legal heirs of respective deceased employees, who were working with the respondent authorities since 1989 to 1994 onwards and continuously worked till their death. Learned counsel submits that in view of the same, the applicants are entitled to get the benefits of permanency in view of the G.R. dated 31.01.1996, as they were appointed as Van Majoors on Class-IV post and discharging their duties as daily wager since 1989 onwards continuously. Learned counsel submits that in view of the same, the proposal to that effect dated 28.12.2017 came to be forwarded by respondent No. 5 to respondent Nos. 3 & 4, which is still pending and as such, the applicants have got a continuous cause of action. Learned counsel submits that in view of the same, there is

no delay as such and in case if the delay has been caused technically, the deceased employee or their legal heirs, who were the applicants before this Tribunal are not responsible for any inaction or negligence.

- 3. Learned Presenting Officer submits that there is an inordinate delay of more than 04 years, which has not satisfactorily explained by the applicant. The Misc. Application is therefore liable to be dismissed.
- 4. On careful perusal of the affidavit in reply to this M.A. filed on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 7, it is not disputed by the respondents that the deceased employees were in service of the respondent authority on Class-IV post as daily wager and in terms of the G.R. dated 31.01.1996, they were prima-facie entitled for claiming the regularization and other consequential benefits. In view of the same, proposal dated 28.12.2017, which was forwarded by respondent No. 5 is still pending before the respondent Nos. 3 & 4. It further appears from the contentions raised in para No. 5 of the reply that the only grievance has been raised is that

the applicants have directly issued the legal notice to the respondent authorities, instead of pursuing the authorities to decide the said proposal.

5. In view of above, since the said proposal is still pending, I find that there is a continuous cause of action. Furthermore there is an inaction on part of respondent Nos. 3 & 4 to keep the said proposal pending from 2017 till this date. In view of the above discussions and for the reasons stated in the application, the delay caused in filing the accompanying O.A., which appears to be technical, deserves to be condoned. Hence, the following order:-

#### ORDER

- (i) The M.A. No. 295/2022 is hereby allowed in terms of prayer clause 8(B).
- (ii) The delay caused in filing the accompanying O.A. is condoned.

- 2. By filing the Original Application the applicant is challenging the order passed by the Sub-Divisional Officer, Sailu dated 11.11.2019, wherein it is stated that the validity of the selection list is of one year and therefore the candidature of the applicant cannot be considered for the post of Police Patil.
- 3. The facts of this case are peculiar. In the year 2015 in response to the recruitment process announced for the post of Police Patil of village Jununwadi, Tq. Jintur, Dist. Parbhani, the applicant and so also the other eligible candidate had applied for appointment for the said post of Police Patil. In the said recruitment process one Amol Sahebrao Ghansawant since acquired maximum marks compared to the others, appointed as Police Patil.

He had worked on the said post for about three years. However, in the year 2016 itself the applicant had approached to this Tribunal by filing Original Application No. 771/2016 challenging the said appointment mainly on the ground that the selected candidate has 3 children and 3<sup>rd</sup> child is after the cut-off date. By order dated 26.03.2018 this Tribunal has permitted the applicant to withdraw the application with liberty to file an application before the Sub-Divisional Officer to raise the same objection in respect of the appointment of the said candidate.

- 4. By order dated 09.05.2019, the respondent No.3 has decided the said application/appeal and sustained the objection raised by the applicant and thereby declared that the appointee Amol Sahebrao Ghansawant is disqualified for the reason of having 3<sup>rd</sup> child after the cut-off date and accordingly cancelled his appointment as Police Patil of said village.
- 5. The applicant thereafter has approached the authorities by filing an application dated 04.06.2019

requesting therein to appoint him as Police Patil as next eligible candidate in terms of waiting list. However by impugned order dated 14.08.2019 the respondent No.3 has rejected the said application on the sole ground that the said waiting list is only valid for the period of one year and thereafter it has lapsed.

- 6. Learned P.O. has placed reliance in a case the **State of Karnataka & Ors. Vs. Smt. Bharathi S**. In paragraph No. 11 of the said case the Hon'ble Supreme Court has made the following observations:-
  - "11. The position that emerges from the above decisions is that the duty to fill up vacancies from the *Additional List (waiting list)* can arise only on the basis of a mandatory rule. In the absence of such a mandate, the decision to fill all the vacancies from the *Additional List*, is left to the wisdom of the State. We will however add that State cannot act arbitrarily and its action will be subject to judicial review."
- 7. In the present case there is no direct provision to determine the life of the waiting list and in terms of the ratio laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court

even if left to the wisdom of the State, as observed by the Hon'ble Apex Court, the State Government cannot act arbitrarily and its action would be subject to judicial review.

- 8. In the instant case the applicant has rightly approached to this Tribunal in the year 2016 and thereafter, in terms of the liberty granted by this Tribunal approached to the respondent No.3 by filing an application raising the same objection about the disqualification of the selected candidate. Thus the respondent No. 3 i.e. S.D.O. has decided the said issue in the year 2019, however, failed to pass any order in connection with the appointment of the applicant as Police Patil even she had secured the next highest marks in the entire recruitment process and she is held to be eligible in respect of the other issues.
- 9. It is not disputed by the learned P.O. that at present the respondents are likely to be issued the advertisement tomorrow. Prima-facie, the impugned order appears to be arbitrary and not in accordance

with the Government policy about the life of waiting list. Hence the following order:-

### ORDER

- (A) The Misc. Application is hereby allowed.
- The respondents shall not publish the (B) advertisement calling thereby the applications for the post of Police Patil of village Jununwadi, Tq. Jintur Dist. Parbhani and in case, if the advertisement is published, no effect shall be given to it till further order.
- (C) In the circumstances, there shall be no order as to costs.
