- 2. The applicants who are working as Office Superintendent and Deputy Accountant respectively in the office of Project Officer, Integrated Tribal Development Project Office, Mumbai and Jawhar respectively are challenging the orders dated 30.1.2023 passed by respondent no.1 terminating their services. The applicants also pray that respondents be directed to pay Rs.25,00,000/- (Rupees twenty five lakhs only) as compensation to each of the applicants.
- 3. Ld. Advocate for the applicants submits that services of the applicants are terminated on the ground that their appointments were not made as per roster. Ld. Advocate submits that both the applicants have submitted their caste verification certificate.
- 4. Ld. Advocate for the applicants submits that applicant no.1 has joined service on 13.1.2015 and applicant no.2 has joined service on 17.1.2015. Both the applicants have joined service pursuant to advertisement dated 19.2.2014 for 16 posts. Ld. Advocate submits that applicants have cleared the examination and their names appeared in the merit list as they were found eligible. Applicant no.1 was appointed in OBC category and applicant no.2 was appointed in NT-B category. It is further submitted that their probation period was completed on 26.3.2019 and 10.11.2017 respectively. The applicant no.1 passed departmental examination on 23.10.2018 and his services were made permanent by issuing order dated 27.6.2019. The applicant no.1 was promoted to the post of Office Superintendent on 17.5.2021.
- 5. Ld. Advocate for the applicants submits that no notice was given to the applicants. The applicants have not played any fraud and there was no fault of the applicant in the appointment process. Thus, the termination orders are illegal and they are to be stayed.
