He relies on para 6 & 7 of the judgment and order dated 27.4.2010 passed by this Tribunal in OA No.42/2010 Shri Shrinivas Prakash Dasari Vs. The Additional Superintendent of Police, Solapur.

- 2. Learned Advocate for Applicant states that the Applicant who is 'Police Inspector' was serving on the post of 'Incharge' of 'Kavathemahanakal Police Station, District Sangli' where he was posted recently on 03.09.2023.
- 3. Learned Advocate for Applicant further states that he is now transferred on 31.01.2024 by Order of 'S.P. Sangli' which only mentions that it for temporary deployment until further orders in the 'Control Room'. The 'S.P. Sangli' has used the phrase 'नव्याने कर्तव्य (DUTY)' and it does not refer to any provision of law under 'Section 22N(2)' of 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951'.
- 4. Learned Advocate for Applicant further states that on the same day 'S.P., Sangli' by Order dated 31.01.2024 has transferred 'Respondent No.2' who was shown as working in 'Control Room' to the post of Applicant which is 'Incharge' of 'Kavathemahanakal Police Station, District Sangli'.
- 5. Learned P.O. states that the order of Respondent No.2 has been issued under provision of 'Section 22N(2)' of 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951' and also states that 'Respondent No.2' has since joined on the post of 'Incharge' of 'Kavathemahanakal Police Station, District Sangli'.

6. Learned P.O. therefore seek one day time to ascertain from 'S.P., Sangll' about the nature of orders of Applicant dated 31.01.2024. Further under what circumstances as many as '7 Police Officers' of the rank of 'Police Inspectors' were shown as serving in 'Control Room' when again they came to be posted to different 'Police Station' on 31.01.2024. Learned P.O. will also ascertain what is the number of 'Sanctioned Posts of 'Police Inspectors' for the 'Control Room'.

- 7. The prayer about the grant of 'Interim Relief' will be considered after requisite information is furnish by learned P.O.
- 8. The office objections, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.
