- 2. The Applicant has challenged order dated 31.03.2021 passed by Respondent No.1 Director General and Inspector General of Police, whereby transfer order of the Applicant dated 19.09.2018 from Hingoli to Pimpri-Chinchwad has been cancelled and the Applicant was directed to join at Hingoli.
- 3. The Applicant was serving as Police Inspector in S.R.P.F Hingoli. He had made request to transfer him to Mumbai. Accordingly Respondent No.1 by order dated 19.09.2018 transferred him to Pimpri-Chinchwad in Motor Transport Department, invoking section 22 N (2) of Maharashtra Police Act, 1967. Since then the Applicant was regularly working there. However, abruptly Respondent No.1 by order dated 31.03.2021 sent the Applicant back to Hingoli stating that there is no sanctioned post of Police Inspector on the establishment of Pimpri-Chinchwad.
- 4. Learned Advocate for the Applicant prayed for interim relief contending that there is no approval of Police Establishment Board (P.E.B.) for transfer of the Applicant from Pimpri-Chinchwad to Hingoli, and further, pointed out the Applicant is displaced only to accommodate one Shri Amit Kumar Lingade.

mount

- 5. Learned P.O. submits that Shri A.K. Lingade was temporarily posted to Pimpri-Chinchwad by order dated 07.04.2021, considering his difficulties and requested for transfer at Pimpri-Chinchwad, he therefore opposed grant of interim of relief.
- 6. Indeed, if there was no sanctioned post of Police Inspector in Motor Transport Department at Pimpri-Chinchwad, then initially in 2018 itself he would not have been transferred at that post. Therefore, the reason now shown in impugned order that there is no such sanctioned post is difficult to digest.
- 7. Secondly, there is no approval of P.E.B. as contemplated under Section 22 N (2) of Maharashtra Police Act, 1967. Respondent No.1 Director General and Inspector General of Police at his level only transferred the Applicant which is *prima-facie* midterm and mid-tenure transfer.
- 8. Thus, *prima-facie* the Applicant seems to have been displaced only to accommodate Shri A.K. Lingade without following due process of law.
- 9. In view of above, I am satisfied that impugned order dated 21.03.2021 is not in consonance of Maharashtra Police Act and same is liable to be stayed.
- 10. Interim relief as prayed in 10 (a) is granted.



Dere, learned Advocate for respondent no.9 in OA No.1084 of 2019 submits that before Aurangabad Bench when the said respondents had appeared as Interveners in OA No.722/2019 at that time Shri A.S. Deshpande, Ld. Advocate for the applicants has made a statement that it is necessary to add 154 candidates besides these 636 candidates. Ld. Advocate for the applicants to take note.
- 7. Shri M.S. Bhandari, learned Advocate has filed MA No.410 of 2019 in OA No.733 of 2019 for Intervention.

- In O.A.No.977/2019, the learned Counsel has produced a chart. Taken on record and marked as Exhibit-1. He submits that this chart is prepared by the Respondent No.1 who is the appointing authority. The learned Counsel submits that this Exhibit-1 chart discloses the vacancy of the posts in all the three Original Applications.
