Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that however, the Respondent-State by order dated 7.6.2022 has appointed Respondent no. 3 on the said post. He submits that the order be stayed qua the Respondent no. 3. Learned counsel for the applicant relies on the judgment of the Hon'ble Bombay High Court, Nagpur Bench in W.P 2670/2017 dated 11.9.2017, Sneha S. Farkade Vs. State of Maharashtra & Ors, wherein the Respondent no. 3 therein the same Respondent no. 3 in the present Original Application. The said Writ Petition the horizontal migration was allowed and the Writ Petition was also allowed. Learned counsel for the applicant relies on the observations made by the Hon'ble High Court as under:-

"Ms Sujata Supnekar and Sangita Nemade would be entitled to the appointment on the two posts meant for open (Women) category as they have secured the first and second highest marks from amongst all the women candidates irrespective of the category from which they applied."

Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that MPSC has challenged the said order before the Hon'ble Supreme Court. It was upheld by the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
