- Government dated 18.01.2021 and pointed out that during the pendency of O.A., the Applicant who was in Group-B is promoted and posted as Assistant Commissioner, Group-A Municipal Council Administration, Divisional Commissionerate Office, Aurangabad. She has also tendered the copy of application made by Applicant dated 27.01.2021 for relieving her as well as relieving order dated 04.02.2021. The orders tendered by learned P.O. is taken on record and marked by letter 'X'.

#### Tribunal's orders

- 5. Thus, admittedly during the pendency of O.A., the Applicant has been promoted and posted at Aurangabad. She had applied to relieve her and accordingly she is relieved. As such, she has accepted the promotion and posting at Aurangabad.
- 6. In view of above, O.A. itself has become infructuous and challenge to transfer order dated 11.08.2020 does not survive.
- 7. Despite, above position, learned Counsel for the Applicant sought one week time to file affidavit stating that Applicant had accepted the promotion subject to her right to challenge the transfer order.
- 8. Once the Applicant is promoted and posted at Aurangabad, the question of surviving transfer order dated 11.08.2020 itself does not survive since in view of promotion to the post of Assistant Commissioner, Group-A, Aurangabd she could not be reposted on initial posting as Chief Officer, Chakan, Municipal Council even if O.A. is allowed. Question of retaining liberty to challenge transfer order does not arise since initial course of action itself has become non-existent and dead in law.
