- 2. The Applicant is serving as Sub Divisional Officer, Wai, Dist. Satara were he was posted by order dated 06.08.2021 but he is displaced by impugned order dated 07.02.2023 whereby Government posted Respondent No.2 in his place leaving the Applicant without posting. The Applicant has therefore filed the present O.A. challenging order dated 07.02.2023 *inter-alia* contending that he is being transferred mid-term and mid-tenure in contravention of Provision of Transfer Act 2005 and prayed for interim relief.
- 3. Learned P.O. has tendered the file for the perusal of the Tribunal and all that she submits that Respondent No.2 is posted in place of the Applicant in view of the note of the Minister of the Department and it is approved by Hon'ble Chief Minister as a competent authority for such mid-term and mid-tenure transfer.
- 4. Surprising to note that there was no proposal for the Transfer of Respondent No.2 as well as the Applicant. Matter was placed before the CSB in respect of transfer of 11 other officials but when the file was placed before the Minister of the Department he made certain addition that Respondent No.2 be placed in place of the Applicant and the noting was simply approved by Hon'ble Chief Minister. Thus neither there is recommendation of CSB nor there is any such necessity or administrative reason to displace the Applicant from his present post. *Ex-facie* it is done only to accommodate Respondent No.2 The note of Minister is simply approval by Hon'ble Chief Minister without bothering to see that no such case is made out to displace the Applicant mid-term and mid-tenure. Only because

Hon'ble Chief Minister approved transfer that *ex-facto* would not render transfer order legal and valid. Under Section 4 (5) of transfer Act 2005 such mid-term and midtenure transfer is permissible only in special case after regarding reasons in writing for the same which is completely missing rather knowingly that there is no such exigency transfer order is issued only to accommodate Respondent No.2 by giving undue favour to him.

- 5. Suffice to say ex-facie impugned transfer order is in blatant contravention of Provision of Transfer Act, 2005 and liable to be stayed immediately.
- 6. In view of above, interim-relief in terms of Para 10 (a) is granted.
- 7. The office objections, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.
- 8. Issue notice before admission returnable on 23.02.2023 to Respondent as to why interim relief should not be made absolute and why O.A. should not be allowed with exemplary cost.
- 9. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondent intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Private service is allowed. Respondents are put to notice that the case may be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
- 10. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.

2. The Tribunal has disposed of O.A.No.802/2021 by order dated 29.03.2022 by giving directions. Para Nos.8 and 9 of the order are

- ***8.** Thus, having heard learned Counsel for the Applicant and learned P.O. for the Respondents, present O.A. can be disposed of by giving suitable directions particularly having noticed that the Respondent No.2- Shri Shelke is posted at Kolhapur from 2016 and had already secured 2-3 extensions. Thus, in general transfer of May, 2022, he will be completing I more than six years. Significantly, the record shows that 1 earlier also he was at Kolhapur from 2002 to 2008. It is quite un-understandable how a person can be posted at one place for such a longer period which is nothing but undue favour.
- **9.** O.A. is, therefore, disposed of with directions to Applicant to make representation giving option of Kolhpaur and Respondent No.1 should consider the same in general transfer of May, 2022 in the light of observations made by this Tribunal as above."
- 3. Now this M.A. is filed for modification of above order on the ground that no general transfers were effected in 2022. The general transfers of 2023 are due in the month of April or May in terms of Transfer Act 2005'. The learned Advocate for the Applicant has pointed out that the Department had called for options in general transfers. In the said Circular,

- 2. This M.A. is filed to condone the delay of 31 months caused in filing O.A. challenging orders dated 03.07.2019 and 23.11.2019 whereby request of the Applicant for change in date of birth has been rejected, In service book, date of birth is 25.02.1965. However, he contends that his correct date of birth is 25.12.1967. The department however rejected his request. Being aggrieved by it, he initially filed W.P. No.4478/2021 before the Hon'ble High Court which was disposed of as withdrawn with liberty to approach the Tribunal by order dated 03.02.2023.
- 3. Learned Counsel the Applicant therefore submits that delay be condoned so as to decide the O.A. on merit.
- 4. In terms of order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Suo-Motu W.P.No.3/2020, dated 10.01.2022 directions were issued for extension of period of limitation in view of Covid-19 pandemic situation and lockdown. The Hon'ble Supreme Court held that in case where the limitation would have expired during the period between 15.03.2020 till 28.02.2022, notwithstanding the actual balance period of limitation remaining, all person shall have a limitation period of 90 days from 01.03.2022.
- 4. In present case, limitation challenged impugned orders expired in period covered by the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court. Thereafter, he filed W.P. which is withdrawn with liberty to approach the Tribunal.
- 5. In view of above, I am inclined to condone the delay caused in filing O.A.
- 6. M.A. is accordingly allowed and disposed of with no order as to costs.
