<u>O R D E R</u>

1. Heard Shri K.R. Jagdale, learned Advocate for the Applicants and Shri A.J. Chougule, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

2. In this OA the applicants are challenging the reversion order dated 12.5.2020 issued by respondent no.2 – The Chief Conservator of Forest (Territory), Forest Circle, Kolhapur. Both the applicants by order dated 30.4.2020 are promoted from the post of Forest Guard to the post of Forester on the basis of provisional seniority list dated 1.6.2015. However, as per the case of the applicants the earlier order of promotion was withdrawn by order dated 12.5.2020 and they were reverted to their earlier post of Forest Guard.

3. Shri K.R. Jagdale, learned Advocate for the applicants relied on Rule 4(1) of the MCS (Regulation of Seniority) Rules, 1982 wherein the date of joining is the date of seniority. As per the submission of the Ld. Advocate for the applicants contained in the OA it is found that Departmental Promotion Committee (DPC) was held on 7.11.2019 and the promotion was given to the applicants as per select list prepared on 1.1.2015. No challenge was given to the said seniority list till 2.11.2019. The Association of Maharashtra Forest Guards and Foresters, Nagpur Branch, Kolhapur raised objections to the seniority list on 2.11.2019. The Ld. Advocate for the applicants pointed out that as per the seniority list rules the challenge can be posed within 15 days from the date of publication of the provisional seniority list and not thereafter.

4. Thus the respondents State is required to find out and answer the following queries made by us:

- (a) Whether the list prepared on 1.1.2015 is provisional or final?
- (b) If final, then furnish the date of publication of the seniority list?

(c) What decision was taken by the respondents in respect of the objections of the Association dated 2.11.2019?

(d) Produce GR No.SRV.1076/12 dated 21.6.1982.

(e) Whether promotions given to the applicants by order dated 30.4.2020 was temporary in nature?

(f) If temporary, then prior notice before reversion order is required? If required, whether it was served?

(g) What posting the applicants are holding as of today i.e. Forest Guard or Forester and whether the order of reversion is executed as of today?

The above query is made with a view to take decision on interim relief which is asked for. S.O. to 11.6.2020 for considering interim relief.
