Chougule, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.</li> <li>During the course of Final Hearing it is transpired that <i>prima-facie</i> the Applicant was not fulfilling eligibility criteria for appointment from part time candidature category. She has fairly disclosed in her application that she has experience of six months only as a causal employee whereas requirement was of three years experience from that category. Despite this position the Applicant was appointed by order dated 07.08.2019 which is signed by Director of Economics and Statistic Mumbai.</li> </ol>		
	3. In Appointment order it was stated that concerned Head Office should further verify eligibility criteria etc of the candidates and then only to get the candidate joined. In present case the Applicant was appointed in the office of District Statistic Office, Ratnagiri. This being the position it was for the Head Office, Ratnagiri to verify eligibility of the Applicant. However, apparently without verifying it the Applicant was allowed to join and she worked for near about four years. Thereafter, only she came to be terminated on the ground that she was not eligible for want of three years experience.

4. During the course of argument learned Advocate for the Applicant in his submission heavily emphasized for claiming damages from the Respondent on the ground that now the Applicant has become age barred for another job and had her candidature rejected at appropriate time she would have tried for another job.

5. In my considered opinion, *prima-facie* there is negligence and carelessness on the part of concerned to verify eligibility of the Applicant for appointment. It is therefore necessary to know whether Department has taken any action against the concerned person responsible for the said lapses and final action, if any.

6. Today Shri Vijay Ahire, Director in the office Directorate of Economics and Statistic is present and states that enquiry was conducted in the matter. He joined as Director of Economics and Statistic on 01.07.2021, he want to verify the record and to file Affidavit.

7. Learned P.O. is directed to file Affidavit to explain the action taken against the concerned officials for the said lapses. Affidavit **will** be filed on Tuesday.

1. Heard Shri S.D Patil, learned advocate for the applicants and Ms Swati Manchekar, learned C.P.O for the Respondents.

As per directions of the Hon'ble Bombay High 2. Court dated 22.12.2021 in W.P 8319/2021, to hear this matter expeditiously, the said order was placed before us for the first time on 11.3.2022. We have fixed hearing of the matter today, i.e. 9.6.2022. At the time of hearing it is found that the applicants who have applied in the reserved category though have not secured more marks either in the open category or reserved category than the cut-off marks, they have filed this Original Application that the persons who are already selected and appointed in the reserved category, i.e. 13 candidates in the reserved category, but have secured more marks than the cut-off marks in the open category, if they are shifted and shown selected from the open category, then the applicants who have secured less than the cut-off marks in the reserved category can enter in their respective reserved categories and can be accommodated.

3. We understand that assuming this relief is granted to the applicants, the other Respondents no 7 to 19 who are already selected in the open category on 8.3.2019, they are selected and appointed in 2020 and are working at different places, will lose their appointment. However, they are contesting this application. Moreover, the persons who have also sought the benefits of reservation, who are selected in their respective reserved category, they have not been made party with the impression that they are otherwise not going to be affected, if they are accommodated in open category.

4. We are of the view that these persons have neither approached any Tribunal nor approached the M.P.S.C or the Government till today seeking that they are to be accommodated in the open category.

5. However, we call upon Counsel of both the parties to show any law where the Court suo moto can pass the order in absence of such candidates or such persons who are not before the Tribunal, by disturbing the reservation. Learned counsel for the applicant is called upon to show the judgment of the Hon'ble Bombay High Court or the Tribunal on the point that migration is allowed even if the benefit of age relaxation is availed of.
