- 2. Today when the matter is taken up for consideration, learned P.O. submitted separate affidavits in reply on behalf of respondent no.1 as well as respondent no.2. Those are taken on record. Copies thereof are served on the other side. We have gone through the contents of the said affidavits in reply. It *prima facie* appears that, both the replies are filed without reading the order passed by this Tribunal, contempt of which is alleged in the present petition.
- 3. The applicant approached this Tribunal by filing the O.A.No.716/2024 praying for directions against the respondents to open the sealed cover and consider him for his promotion. Report in respect of the applicant was kept in sealed cover for the reason that a criminal case was pending against him and

the departmental enquiry was also pending against him. When the O.A. was heard, it was brought to our notice that the Special Court has acquitted the applicant of the charges levelled against him. It was also brought on record that, the departmental enquiry has also been closed.

- 4. At the relevant time Government had taken a stand that criminal appeal filed by the Government against the acquittal of the applicant is pending before the Hon'ble High Court. Considering the said fact and recording that mere pendency of criminal appeal may not come in the way of the applicant for considering him for promotion if he is otherwise eligible subject to outcome of the said criminal appeal, following order was passed in the said O.A.:
 - "[i] Respondents are directed to issue the order of completion of probation period of the applicant if there is no other impediment in that regard within 2 weeks from the date of this order.
 - [ii] Respondents are further directed to break open the sealed cover within 4 weeks from the date of this order and if the applicant is recommended therein for his promotion, consider his case for promotion on merit in order of seniority and as per rules.

[iii] O.A. stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms, however, without any order as to costs.

[iv] M.A. also stands dispose of accordingly."

5. Since the order was not complied with the applicant issued legal notice to the authorities praying for compliance of the order. Despite that, when the order was not complied with by the respondents the applicant preferred the present contempt petition. When the contempt petition was heard, learned Counsel appearing for the applicant brought to our notice that, the Hon'ble High Court has refused to grant leave to appeal against the acquittal of the present applicant and also placed on record copy of the said order passed on 12-04-2024. After having considered the material which was filed on record along with contempt petition, we reached to a prima facie conclusion that without any cogent reason the order of the Tribunal has not been complied with. In the circumstances, notice in the prescribed form i.e. Form No.III was directed to be issued and the respondents were called upon to appear in person or through counsel and to submit their response to the contentions raised in the contempt petition. Accordingly, today respondents have submitted their affidavits in reply.

- From the contents of the affidavit, it is revealed 6. that the same stand has been reiterated by the respondents for not considering the applicant for promotion. A case is therefore made out to proceed against the respondents under the provisions of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
- 7. As provided in the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Contempt of Courts) Rules, 1996 the charge is required to be framed as provided under Form IV appended to the said Rules. circumstances, we direct both the respondents to remain present before this Tribunal on 12-11-2024 for framing charge against them.

2. S.O. to 20.11.2024. The interim relief granted earlier to continue till then.

ORAL ORDER:

Heard Shri Amol A. Kokad, learned counsel for the applicant and Shri V.G. Pingle, learned Presenting Officer for the respondent authorities.

2. The applicant had applied for the post of Senior Clerk in pursuance of the advertisement No. 2/2022 issued by respondent No. 2 on 17.02.2023. applicant applied for the said post and in the selection process he secured merit No. 320 in the revised provisional select list. The said list was published on 24.11.2023. The selected candidates were called for document verification at Mumbai on 26.02.2024. It is the contention of the applicant that he could not reach to Mumbai on the said date because all the roads around Beed were blocked by agitations, seeking reservation in Government Employment for Maratha's. It is the further contention of the applicant that even internet service was not available on the said date. Learned counsel further submitted that even the notification by

which the candidates were called upon to remain present for document verification at Mumbai on 26.02.2024 came to be noticed by the applicant belatedly.

- 3. Learned counsel submitted that even otherwise the applicant could not have reached to Mumbai on the said date because of the aforesaid hurdle. Learned counsel submitted that on the same date the applicant tried to send mail bringing to the notice of the authorities that because of agitation (मराठा आंदोलन) he is unable to reach to Mumbai, but due to internet problem mail could not be reached to the authorities. Applicant subsequently also tried and grievance was ultimately reached to the respondents, but the applicant did not receive any response. The applicant, therefore, has approached this Tribunal seeking directions against respondent No. 2 to verify documents in respect of the applicant and consider the applicant for his appointment if he is otherwise entitled for that.
- 4. Learned Presenting Officer fairly submitted that the applicant deserves to be given an

opportunity for his document verification. It is brought to our notice that the third round of document verification is scheduled on 11.10.2024. We are convinced that the applicant for valid reason could not attend the document verification on the earlier occasion i.e. on 26.02.2024. When the applicant has secured place in the list of eligible candidates, on the aforesaid ground he shall not lose opportunity of being selected. In the circumstances, we are inclined to pass the following order: -

ORDER

- i) Respondent No. 2 shall allow the applicant to appear for document verification on 11.10.2024 and if not convenient on the said date, on any other suitable next date.
- ii) The Original Application stands disposed of in the aforesaid term. There shall be no order as to costs.
- iii) Steno copy is allowed to both the parties.
