In the present O.A., the Applicant has challenged the impugned transfer order dated 31.05.2019 mainly on the ground that though the Applicant is due to retire on 31.08.2019, he was transferred in contravention of Section 5(1)(a) of Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as 'Transfer Act, 2005'.)

	 In the present O.A., in all these Original Applications, the Applicants are seeking stay to impugned order dated 31.05.2019 whereby they have been transferred to different police stations within the area of Commissionerate, Pune.
	3. In terms of order passed by this Tribunal on 06.06.2019, the directions were issued to the Respondent No.2 to clarify inconsistency in between two orders passed on the same day i.e. 31.05.2019. In first order, the Applicants were shown transferred to Police Head Quarter whereas in 2 nd order, they were shown transferred to different police stations.
	4. Learned P.O. for the Respondents clarified that the 2 nd order transferring the Applicants to different police stations is valid one and pointed out that mistakenly the 1 st order was issued without issuing posting of specific police station and the corrigendum has been accordingly issued.
	5. In fact, there ought to have been reference to corrigendum in 2 nd order whereby the different police stations have been allotted to the Applicants.
	6. Be that as it may, the fact remains that the

corrigendum was issued and it is 2nd order, whereby the Applicants are transferred to different police stations is final

Tribunal's orders

- 7. The learned Advocate for the Applicants prayed for interim relief on the ground that none of the Applicant has completed normal tenure and the ground shown for transfer i.e. administrative exigency is not sustainable in law. Learned Advocate further sought to contend that the transfer appears punitive and, therefore, deserves to be stayed.
- 8. Learned P.O. for the Respondents has tendered a copy of Minutes of Police Establishment Board (PEB) which shows that the Applicants who were earlier attached to Social Security Cell have been transferred to different police stations within the Commissionerate area on the ground of public interest and on account of administrative exigency. Thus, it appears that PEB invoked Section 22 (N) (2) of the Maharashtra Police Act and found it necessary to transfer the Applicants amongst other to various police stations. In PEB, it is noted that the transfers of the Applicants to the various police stations is necessitated so as to avail their services for public at large and thought it necessary to transfer them to various police stations on account of administrative exigency.
- 9. Merely because the Applicants have been transferred mid-term, it cannot be termed as punitive transfer. PEB under Section 22(N) and 22(2) is empowered to make such mid-term transfer in public interest and on account of administrative exigency.
- 10. Prima-facie, the Applicants have been transferred to various police stations from Social Security Cell on administrative exigency.
- 11. I am, therefore, not inclined to grant interim stay. The Respondents are directed to file reply.
- 12. Learned P.O. also pointed that majority of Applicants have already relieved and joined their new place of postings.
- 13. Learned Advocate for the Applicants is allowed to file service affidavit.
- 14. S.O. to 25.06.2019.

- 5. The Applicant in O.A.No.862/2018 has also initiated contempt proceeding.

- 7. The disobedience of the order passed by this Tribunal as well as inaction and lethargy on the part of Chief Engineer, Minor Irrigation Local Sector, Pune is obvious from the record. There is absolutely no hurdle to finalise the pensionary benefits of the Applicant but seems to have been not processed due to sheer negligence and mal administration.
