When the present matter is taken up for consideration, learned Presenting Officer seeks one week's time to file affidavit in reply on behalf of the contesting respondent i.e. Maharashtra Public Service Commission. Learned counsel pointed out that certain progress has taken place in the matter and the candidates whose names are included in the list of recommended candidates are required to submit their bonds. 3. It appears to us that the matter needs to be heard on merits and unless MPSC comes out with the reply, it may not be so considered. On the other hand the apprehension expressed by the applicant that in the meanwhile respondents may issue orders of appointment is also not misplaced. Learned counsel for the applicant has placed on record document dated 30.05.2024 which reveals that the respondents have called upon the selected candidates to execute the bond in the prescribed format.

4. Having considered the facts as aforesaid, we deem it appropriate to pass the following order: -

**ORDER**

(i) Time granted to the M.P.S.C. to file reply till 19.06.2024. In the meanwhile if the respondents decide to issue orders of appointment, one post shall be kept vacant until further orders from this Tribunal.

(ii) S.O. to 19.06.2024.
