4. Learned PO then mentions that as per directions in 'Para 3' of Order dated 08.04.2024 the 'Dy. Director Health Services, Nashik Division Nashik' has now recommended on 19.04.2024 that Applicant may be transferred to either (a) Trauma Care Unit, Satana District Nashik (b) General Hospital; Malegaon, District Nashik (c) Trauma Care Unit, Sangamaner, District Ahmednagar.

5. The 'Additional Chief Secretary, Public Health Department to thus consider the earlier requests of Applicant as well as recommendations made by 'Dy.
