Advocate submits that first time he was considered for promotion in DPC held on 1.11.2021 and he was found eligible and was called to give option for posting in Divisional Cadre on 29.10.2021. He submitted the options immediately. However, revised list was published on 2.11.2021 and name of the applicant was dropped and other officers were promoted by order dated 17.11.2021. Applicant made representation on 24.1.2022 and 23.6.2022 to treat his earlier suspension period from 22.8.2005 to 23.2.2012. Charge sheet of DE was issued on 27.10.2010. Punishment was imposed on 5.7.2017 of withholding one increment for years without cumulative effect. He refers to Rule 6(a) of Recruitment Rules. He submits that report is submitted on 8.3.2022 pursuant to his representation. He was acquitted from criminal case No.85/2005 on 29.9.2016 and other CR No.93/2005 is pending before Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate and the complaint has expired. For the same reasons DE was initiated and was held guilty on 15.7.2017 imposing punishment of stoppage of increment.</p>

3. He relies on GR dated 15.12.2017. He submits that he should get the benefit of said GR and his case should have been considered for promotion. He relies on the judgment and order dated 11.7.2022 passed by this Tribunal in OA No.770 of 2021 Dayanand N. Kiratkar Vs. DGP & Anr.

4. Ld. CPO submits that DPC was held on 27.7.2021. He became first time eligible for promotion in 2021. Hence, his case was considered in that DPC. Ld. CPO submits that as per reply para 16 the department was not aware of the pendency of second criminal case against the applicant but when it was informed from Commissioner, Lottery they kept his case in sealed cover.
