- 1. Heard Shri S.R Kamble, learned advocate for the applicant and Smt K.S Gaikwad, learned P.O for the Respondents.
- The applicant who was working as Police Constable challenges the order of termination dated 26.5.2010. Apparently, it appears that there is a delay of more than 10 to 11 years. However, in the present case, learned counsel submits that the said order of 26.5.2010 was challenged in appeal before the Respondent-State, Home Department in the year 2017. said appeal was rejected on 15.12.2018. Thereafter, within one year the applicant was required to file the Original Application before the Tribunal. However, he did not file the same. Learned counsel submits that the period of limitation started running from 16.12.2019. Learned counsel further submits that he could not file the Original Application because the applicant was under depression and also suffering from tuberculosis. Thereafter, due to Covid-19 Pandemic, nation wide lockdown was declared from March, 2020, and as per the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court by order dated 10.1.2022 in M.A 21/2022 in M.A 665/2021 in Suo Motu W.P (C) no. 3/2020, has directed that the period of limitation is extended up to February, 2022. Learned counsel submits that the present O.A 580/2022 was filed in July, 2022. Thus, there is a delay of 4 to 5 months in filing the present Original Application, which needs to be condoned considering the health and depression of the applicant.
- 3. Learned C.P.O opposes the application on the ground that there is an inordinate delay.
- 4. We are of the view that there is apparent delay in filing the Original Application. However, the applicant has approached the first Appellate Authority after 7 years and at that time it was necessary to object the said appeal on the ground of delay. However, the appeal was decided on merit and therefore the delay of 7 years was condoned.
- 5. Thus, considering the facts stated above by the learned counsel for the applicant, we condone the delay of 4 to 5 months.
- 6. Misc Application accordingly stands disposed of.

- 4. Thereafter, Applicant No.1 made representation on 03.01.2022 requesting to substitute the name of his son in her place in the waiting list. However, it is rejected by communication dated 23.03.2022 which is challenged in the present O.A.
- 5. Thus, the fact remains that still the name of Applicant No.1 is in the waiting list.

- 6. Learned Counsel for the Applicant sought to contend that now the Applicant No.1 is around 41 years old and considering long waiting list, there is apprehension of not getting appointment till the age of 45 years.
- 7. Whereas learned P.O. has pointed out that the name of Applicant No.1 is still in the waiting list and whenever her turn comes, necessary steps will be taken for issuance of appointment order.
- 8. In terms of G.R. dated 20.05.2015 once the heir attains age of 45 years, the name is deleted from the waiting list. Thus, it is under apprehension that Applicant No.1 will not get appointment till attaining the age of 45 years, the O.A. is filed for substitution of name of Applicant No.2 in place of Applicant No.1.
- 9. When the issue of maintainability of O.A. brought to the notice of learned Counsel for the Applicant that since admittedly the name of Applicant No.1 is in the waiting list and O.A. is premature, he sought permission to withdraw the O.A. with liberty to approach the Tribunal, if she does not get appointment or her name is deleted from the waiting list.
- 10. As of now, the fact remains that name of the Applicant No.1 is in the waiting list and whether she will be given compassionate appointment before she attains 45 years or not, is the only guesswork and nothing can be said conclusively at this stage. As of now, there is no cause of action.
- 11. In view of above, allowed to withdraw O.A. with liberty to approach the Tribunal whenever Applicant gets cause of action for the same as may be permissible in law.
- 12. In view of above, allowed to withdraw the O.A. with no order as to costs.

ORDER

- 1. Applicant has applied for the post of District Civil Surgeon, Maharashtra Medical and Health Services pursuant to advertisement No.272/2021 dated 30.12.2021. However his candidature was rejected on the ground that he did not have experience of more than 5 years of working in the hospital after acquiring post graduation degree. His candidature was rejected vide notification dated 02.11.2022 wherein it was stated that he has worked as Consultant in two hospitals i.e.
 - (i) Vivekanand Hospital (Multispecialty Hospital & Research Center).
 - (ii) Aditya Orthopedic and General Surgical Hospital.

The Applicant has worked as Consultant in these two hospitals which does not amount to full time employment. He submitted the



application to M.P.S.C. on 04.11.2022 stating that he had been declared as ineligible because he has mentioned his designation as Consultant. However he stated that this was inadvertent technical error. He further requested M.P.S.C. to go through his application wherein in the experience certificate of both the hospitals it is clearly mentioned that he has worked on full time basis. He, therefore, prays that he should be allowed to appear for the interview for the post of Civil Surgeon, Maharashtra Medical and Health Services which are currently going-on i.e. on 09.11.2022, 10.11.2022 and 11.11.2022.

- 3. Learned C.P.O. opposes the O.A. on the ground that the applicant has himself stated that he worked as Consultant and this experience cannot be counted as valid experience as per clause 8.1 of the said advertisement dated 30.12.2021. She further pointed out that Consultant can be working in multiple hospitals but the Applicant may not be necessarily working as full time employee in the same hospital.
- 4. We have perused the experience certificate furnished by the Applicant of both hospitals. It is clearly stated that he has worked in the said hospitals as 'Medical Officer Anesthesiologist and Intensive Care Physician'. Hence, in view of the above, prima facie, case has been made out for grant of interim relief. We allow the applicant to appear for the interview tomorrow, subject to the final out-come of this O.A. M.P.S.C. is further directed to allow the applicant to appear for the interview tomorrow i.e. on 11.11.2022.
- 5. The office objections, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.

7. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondent intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Private service is allowed.
