The applicant who is working in a private pharmaceutical company challenges the notification dated 13.1.2017 issued by the Respondent-State regulating the recruitment rules and also prays that the advertisement dated 29.9.2017 issued by the MPSC and so also the announcements dated 10.8.2020 and 21.8.2020 issued by the MPSC and the results declared dated 7.10.2020 are to be quashed and set aside.
- 3. The challenge to the said notification issued by respondent no.1 is mainly on the ground that the said notification has been inconsistent with definition clause Section 2(g) of the All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE) Act defining 'Technical Education' and the notification does not cover 'Pharmacy' under the said Act of Technical Education. Hence, violation of Article 14 of the Constitution of India.
- 4. Ld. CPO pointed out that the State has filed Caveat Application No.47 of 2020. Shri M.D. Lonkar, learned Advocate files Vakalatnama for respondent no.3. Apart from respondent no.3 there are 19 private persons who are declared successful in the impugned examination conducted by the MPSC. Hence, they are also to be served. The applicant is directed to serve all other private persons and file affidavit of service.
- 5. It appears that similar issue was raised by Association of Pharmacy Teachers of India through one Member Shri Saber Hussain Fazal in OA No.592 of 2017 before Aurangabad Bench of this Tribunal and the Division Bench at Aurangabad by order dated 15.3.2019 has allowed the said OA by giving directions to the State to amend the rules. The said order was challenged in Aurangabad Bench of Bombay High Court in W.P. No.8612 of 2019 by Dr. Abhay E. Wagh (Director of Technical Education)

- 2. Perusal of record particularly Police Establishment Board (PEB) Minutes reveals that in the war is a fine point against present Applicant Nos.1 and 2 including Applicant No.3. The Applicant No.1 and 2 were transferred to Yavat and Bhor Police Station. In so far as Respondent No.3 Shri Jyotiram Pawar is concerned, PEB decided to transfer him from Otur Police Station but in view of letter dated 29.06.2019 of Additional Director General of Police (Transport), he was allegedly selected in Highway Police, and therefore, PEB opined that the decision of his transfer is reserved and he was relieved to join Highway Police in view of the letter dated 29.06.2019 purported to issue Additional Director General of Police.
- 3. Accordingly, the Respondent No.1 S.P. (Rural) issued transfer orders dated 26.07.2019.

1. In the 2nd sitting learned P.O. produces the noting dated 04.11.2020 which was signed by the Members of the Civil Services Board and also competent authority the Hon'ble the Minister and then the Hon'ble the Chief Minister and the decision was taken to transfer the applicant from Sindhudurg to Aurangabad. The learned P.O. pointed out that the Hon'ble M.P. Shri Vinayak Raut and the guardian Minister of Sindhudurg informed that there are complaints against the applicant and he was earlier suspended and therefore when the people had knowledge that the applicant is appointed at Sindhudurg as Civil Surgeon, the people expressed their disapproval for the same and so also the private Doctors are also reluctant to render services after appointed of the applicant. Therefore the Hon'ble Minister and the M.P. has recommended that the additional charge can be handed over to Dr. Shripat

Patil and the applicant is to be transferred and therefore, the Respondent transferred the applicant to Aurangabad.

- 2. The Government has every right to transfer any Civil Servant /Government servant, however, by following the rules laid down under the Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred at ROT Act, 2005). The Applicant was transferred from Kothrud to Sindhudurg on 01.10.2020 and he took charge of Sindhudurg hospital on the same day. Thus within two months he was again transferred to Aurangabad. The tenor of the Respondents decision was that the Applicant is transferred at request, as per the letter dated 04.11.2020. On perusal of the said letter, it is found that the Applicant has requested for transfer to Beed in the event of vacancy. He has never asked for his transfer to Aurangabad. The post of Civil Surgeon at Beed was vacant when he made request and the order of Dr. Gite was issued on 26.11.2020.
- 3. The learned P.O. has pointed out that the Hon'ble the Minister had already approved the transfer of Dr. Gite to Beed on 16.09.2020. Hence, the post of Civil Surgeon, Beed was not vacant. Under these circumstances it was necessary on the part of the Respondents to just inform / communicate the applicant that his request for Beed is rejected. Instead the Respondent transferred him to Aurangabad. Thus, it is mid-term and mid-tenure transfer and the reasons given as special case as per Section 4(4) and Section 4(5) of ROT Act, 2005, is the complaints made by the Hon'ble the Minister and the Hon'ble M.P.

4. The learned Counsel has placed reliance on the judgment of this Tribunal filed by Shri Rajesh G. Lande Versus The State of Maharashtra (O.A.No.300 of 2020) dated 06.10.2020, wherein it has discussed about the judgment of Hon'ble High Court in case of **State Of Maharashtra And Anr** vs Dr. (Ms) Padmashir Shriram Bainade in Writ Petition No.9781 of 2014, decided on 17th December, 2014, which has held that,

"Without taking any disciplinary enquiry, if the transfer is effective then it will be transfer whose foundation will be based on misconduct and it has held that transfer if made on unverified complaints or allegations, then it amounts to punishment or punitive action based upon unproved allegations."

- 5. If at all there is complaint against any Civil Servant/ Government servant then the punishment should not be in the nature of transfer, but he should be given opportunity to meet the allegations made against him and they are to be very right.
- 6. In the present case, neither the show cause notice was issued to the Applicant nor any Departmental enquiry was initiated against him. Hence, the order of transferring him is, prima facie, illegal and hereby stayed. The applicant is directed to join Sindhudurg as Civil Surgeon forthwith.
- 7. The learned P.O. to communicate this order to the concerned Respondents.
- 8. S.O. to 22.12.2020 for reply.
