as relates of Shewari village by holding the same that it to be issued on false and bogus proceeding/meeting beand to contravention judgment and order dated 25.06.2007 of Hon'ble High Court passed in Writ Petition No.4175 of 2007 along with Writ Petition No.4202 of 2007 as being contrary to G.R. dated 16.10.2008 as well contrary to roaster/rotation policy and direct Respondents simultaneously thenos.1 to 3 to convene a fresh meeting and provide a reservation to VJ (A), at village Shewari, Taluka - Chalisgaon, Dist. Jalgaon or in alternative to keep the post of Police Patil in respect of village Shewari for open category and to publish proclamation/advertisement accordingly as expeditiously as possible."
