3. Ld. Advocate for the applicant submits that applicant has applied on 4.1.2016 pursuant to advertisement of 28.12.2015. This advertisement is governed by GR dated 30.4.2005 in which power lifting was included in the GR and the criteria of Olympics Games was applied. However, as per GR dated 1.7.2016 power lifting was removed and the criteria of Asian Games, Olympic Games was included. Ld. Advocate submits that his case is to be considered as per earlier GR.

That apart as stated above, the Applicant was given 5. promotion by order dated 20.08.1991 and after completion of 12 years, she was given the benefit of 1st Time Bound Promotion on 04.11.2003. Thereafter, within 12 years she was given promotion to the post of Marathi Stenographer (L.G.) on 28.05.2010. Thus, she got promotion before expiration of 12 years period, and therefore, the question of She retired on grant of 2nd benefit does not survive. superannuation on 30.06.2011. The reliance placed by the Applicant on the decision rendered by the Hon'ble High Court in W.P.No.9051/2013 & Ors. (State of Maharashtra V/s Meena Kuwalekar & Ors.), decided on 28.04. 2016 is totally misplaced. In that case, the issue was considering ad-hoc service for grant of benefit of Time Bound Promotion which is not here.

6. In present case, the Applicant got benefit of 1st Time Bound Promotion before expiration of 12 years' service on the same post and later again before expiration of next 12 years, she was again got promotion on 28.05.2010. This being the admitted position, the claim of the Applicant for benefit of 1st Time Bound Promotion w.e.f. 22.09.1994 and 2nd benefit from 21.09.2006 is totally untenable since the Applicant was not on same post for 12 years. It is only in case, a Government servant could not get promotion and worked on the same post for 12 years, is given benefit of Time Bound Promotion which is known as nonfunctional promotion taking care of stagnation. In present case, there is no such situation since the Applicant was not required to stay without promotion for 12 years.

7. The totality of the aforesaid discussion leads me to conclude that O.A. is devoid of merit and deserves to dismissed. Hence, the order :-
