Learned Advocate on behalf of Respondent No.4 has also filed Affidavit-in-Reply dated 11.01.2024. Both these 'Affidavits-in-Reply' are taken on record.</p> <p>3. Learned Advocate of Applicant thereupon stated that he does not intend to file 'Affidavit-in-Rejoinder' on behalf of Applicant and seeks 'Interim Relief'.</p> <p>4. Learned Advocate for Applicant referred to the 'Affidavit-in-Reply' dated 10.01.2024 filed by Urban Development Department and specifically to contents of 'Para 5' which reads as <i>"Total 28 Group B officers who were working in Class B Municipal Councils were promoted & posted in Class B Municipal Councils vide Government Order dated 18.04.2022 & 25.07.2023. Also, vide another Government Order dated 18.04.2022, Seven Group-B officers were transferred from the "B" Class Municipal Council. As on today 26 Group-B officers are working in 'B' class Municipal Councils."</i></p> <p>5. Learned Advocate for Applicant contended based on disclosures made in 'Affidavit-in-Reply' dated</p> <p align="right">[P.T.O.]</p>

	<p>10.01.2024 that now 'Urban Development Department' has admitted that there are '26 Chief Officer- Group B' who are still working in 'Municipal Councils - B Class'. Further, he emphasized even after 'Transfer Order' dated 15.12.2023 of Applicant came to be issue by 'Urban Development Department' has continued to issue even more 'Transfer Orders' of 'Chief Officers- Group B' to post them in 'Municipal Council-B Class' in open contravention of policy guidelines in 'Urban Development Department' GR dated 28.12.2021. He then produced one such copy of 'Transfer Order' dated 28.12.2023 issued by 'Urban Development Department'.</p> <p>6. Learned Advocate for Applicant argued that it was "Arbitrary Exercise" of "Statutory Powers" by the 'Competent Transferring Authority' that has resulted in 'Transfer Order' dated 15.12.2023 of 'Urban Development Department' by which Applicant was moved out from post of 'Chief Officer, Khopoli Municipal Council, District Raigad'. Further he argued that 'Competent Transferring Authority' and next 'Superior Transferring Authority' have not recorded any 'Special Reasons' or 'Exceptional Circumstances' as was required to be done by them under 'Section 4 (4) (2)' & 'Section 4(5)' of 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005'. Learned Advocate for Applicant stressed that while not accepting recommendation made by 'C.S.B.' they were also required to record the 'Specific Reasons' as per judgment of '<i>Hon'ble Supreme Court in (2013) 15 SCC 732 (T.S.R. Subramanian and Ors. Vs. Union of India & Ors.)</i>'.</p> <p>7. Learned Advocate for the Applicant also referred to provisions of the "Maharashtra Urban Administrative Services (Recruitment) Rules, 2023" brought into effect from 25.01.2023 which under 'Rule (I)' mentions about the cadres of posts included under "Maharashtra Municipal State Services".</p> <p>8. Learned Advocate for Respondent No.3 challenged maintainability of the case of Applicant on grounds that he is still serving as 'Chief Officer-Group B'; whereas, 'Respondent No. 3' being 'Chief Officer - Group A', and as per policy guidelines in Urban</p>

Learned Advocate for Respondent No.3 then stated that 'Respondent No.3' had since taken over charge as 'Chief Officer, Khopali Municipal Council, District Raigad' on 18.12.2023 as per directions in 'Transfer Order' dated 15.12.2023 of 'Urban Development Department'. Also then he emphasized that no 'Interim Relief' had been granted to Applicant even on the earlier dates; primarily upon consideration of the fact that Applicant being 'Chief Officer – Group B' was not entitled to continue on post of 'Chief Officer, Khopali Municipal Council, District Raigad' as per policy guidelines in Urban Development G.R. dated 28.10.2021.</p> <p>10. Learned Advocate for the Respondent No.3 by way of 'Affidavit-in-Reply' dated 11.01.2024 has also referred to directions in 'Election Commissioner of India' letter dated 21.12.2023 regarding the transfer of 'Government Servants' directly connected with conduct of forthcoming 'General Elections to Lok Sabha: 2024'.</p> <p>11. Learned PO stated that 'Rule 2(m)' of the 'Maharashtra Urban Administrative Services (Recruitment) Rules, 2023' clearly indicated that (i) Chief Officer Group A (Selection Grade); (ii) Chief Officer Group A and (iii) Chief Officer Group B are all from "Municipal Council Chief Officer Cadre" under "Maharashtra Urban Administrative Services" Thus: it is evident that 'Chief Officer-Group A' has been placed as senior to 'Chief Officer- Group B' though they are both in "Maharashtra Urban Administrative Services".</p> <p>12. Learned P.O. further pointed out that as per 'Rule 15' of the 'Maharashtra Urban Administrative</p>

Learned Advocate for 'Respondent No.3' again referred to 'Affidavit-in-Reply' dated 11.01.2024 to state that 'Respondent No. 3' had taken 'ex-parte' charge of the post of 'Chief Officer Khopoli Municipal Council; District Raigad' on 18.12.2023 as per as per directions in 'Transfer Order' dated 15.12.2023 of 'Urban Development Department' and then emphatically quoted from Judgment of 'Hon'ble High Court of Bombay' in 'Writ Petition No.7679/2023 dated 28.06.2023' against grant of any 'Interim Relief' to Applicant at this stage by way of '<i>status qua ante</i>'. Considering the fact that 'Respondent No.3' had joined '<i>ex-parte</i>' on the post of "Chief Officer, Khopoli Municipal Council, District Raigad" on 18.12.2023 as per as per directions in 'Transfer Order' dated 15.12.2023 of 'Urban Development Department' grant of 'Interim Relief' at this stage by way of '<i>status-quo-ante</i>' would go against the grain of several judgments of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and Hon'ble High Court of Bombay as it would amount to granting "Interim Mandatory Injunction". Hence the prayer of Applicant for 'Interim Relief' is not granted and 'Respondent No.3' who is 'Chief Officer – Group A' and being eligible as per policy guidelines in Urban Development G.R. dated 28.10.2021 to hold any post which are earmarked only for 'Chief Officer- Group A' is permitted to continue working as 'Chief Officer, Khopoli Municipal Council, District Raigad'.</p> <p>16. The case of Applicant is a classic example of the 'Selective Implementation' of police guidelines 'Urban Development Department' GR dated 28.10.2021 as there is brazen admission of the fact in 'Affidavit-in-Reply dated 10.01.2024 that '26 Chief Officers - Group B' still continue to hold posts in 'Municipal Council B Class' The saga of issuing 'Transfer Orders' of ineligible 'Chief Officers- Group B' to posts in 'Municipal councils – B Group' by 'Urban Development Department' has not abated even after 'Transfer Order' of Applicant was issued on 15.02.2023. The belated but meager effort to attempt implementation of policy guidelines in 'Urban Development Department' GR 28.10.2021 albeit only in case of Applicant soon went astray with issue of another 'Transfer Order' dated 28.12.2023 by which some other 'Chief Officer-Group B' was again posted to 'Municipal Council - B Group'.</p> <p>17. Learned Counsel Mr. Dere for the Applicant has submitted that the D.E. against the Applicant is at the fag end of the completion, therefore he apprehends that if at all he is guilty in D.E. then immediately he will be removed from the service. He has submitted that the Tribunal has protected his service and now his service is to be protected by giving similar orders to the Respondent-State.

4. Under these circumstances, we direct that the State may complete D.E. However, the Respondent-State not to take any coercive action against the applicant.

5. Learned C.P.O. seeks time to file reply in O.A.No.1310/2023.

6. Learned C.P.O. is directed to tender copy of reply to the concern Counsel on 18.01.2024.
