Learned PO states the 'Housing Department' was under the bonafide that the post of 'Competent Authority-1', in 'SRA Mumbai' was vacant as 'Secretary' of 'SRA Mumbai' by 'Office Order' dated 13.10.2023 had given Additional Charge of the post of 'Competent Authority-1' in 'SRA Mumbai' to Shri. Suresh Kashid who was working as 'Tahsildar-3 (Special Cell)' in 'SRA Mumbai'.</p> <p>3. Learned PO thereupon states that she needs 'One Week' time to file 'Affidavit-in-Reply' on behalf of 'Housing Department' as per directions in 'Para 10' of Order dated 06.03.2024.</p> <p>4. Learned PO as per information available states that 'Respondent No. 4' has joined on post of 'Competent Authority-1' in 'SRA Mumbai' on 04.03.2024.</p> <p>5. The Revenue and Forest Department 'Transfer Order' dated 15.02.2024 issued in respect of 'Respondent No. 4' may have been under the belief that the post of 'Competent Authority-1' in 'SRA Mumbai' was vacant and had to be filled up immediately as per directions in Election Commission of India letter dated 21.12.2023. However new fact has now been emerged</p>

	<p>that 'Secretary', 'SRA Mumbai' by 'Office Order' dated 13.10.2023 had given 'Additional Charge' of post of 'Competent Authority-1' in 'SRA Mumbai' to Shri. Suresh Kashid who was working as 'Tahsildar-3 (Special Cell)' in 'SRA Mumbai': Thus question which has arisen now is where was Applicant been shifted to while serving on post of 'Competent Authority-1' in 'SRA Mumbai' as this disclosure has significant bearing about back drop of 'Transfer Order' dated 15.02.2024 of Revenue &amp; Forest Department in respect of 'Respondent No.4'.</p> <p>6. The 'Transfer Order' dated 04.03.2024 of 'Housing Department' cannot be permitted to be brought into effect till the reasons for flip-flop action is explained satisfactorily as already observed in 'Para 10 of Order dated 06.03.2024. Thus 'Respondent No.4' in the interim period is permitted to work 'Vacant Post' of 'Competent Authority-9' in 'SRA Mumbai'. Further claims of Respondent No.4 having joined post of 'Competent Authority-1', in 'SRA Mumbai' must be substantiated by Housing Department by obtaining factual report from 'CEO, SRA'. 1. Heard Shri S.S. Dere, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Shri A.J. Chougule, Smt. K.S. Gaikwad & Smt. Archana B.K., Shri A.D. Gugale and Shri D.R. Patil learned Presenting Officers for the Respondents.
2. Learned PO along with 'Law Officer' on behalf of 'DGP, Maharashtra State' submits letter dated 07.03.2024 of 'Additional Director General of Police (Establishment), Maharashtra State, Mumbai' wherein it has been stated that since instructions given in Election Commission of India, letter dated 21.12.2023 and Chief Electoral Officer, M.S. letter dated 22.02.2024 are now clear; they do not wish to seek any relaxation for Applicants from 'Chief Electoral Officer, Maharashtra State' in view of the fact that deadline for transfers is already over, and as elections are nearing; the police officials need to join where they have been transferred especially considering the fact that total of 73 'A.P.I.' and 212 'P.S.I.' have now been transferred out of their 'Home Districts' by 'Transfer Order' dated 26.02.2024 of 'DGP, Maharashtra State'.
3. Learned Advocate for Applicant thereupon states that Applicant would therefore be willing to join on their new posts as per 'Transfer Order' dated 26.02.2024 of 'DGP, Maharashtra State'. However learned Advocate for Applicants states that contentions of Applicants regarding implementation of provisions of law under 'Section 22(N)' of Maharashtra Police Act 1951 and other 'Administrative Guidelines' issued by Home Department such as about consideration for earlier service in 'LWE' affected areas and serious 'Medical Conditions' etc. must be kept open so as to be heard on merit in due course after 'Affidavits-in-Reply' are filed on behalf of 'DGP, Maharashtra State'.

Learned Advocate for Applicants further states that in respect of 'Transfer Order' dated 26.02.2024 of 'DGP, Maharashtra State' there are still few instances where some 'P.S.I.' who have been transferred on grounds of 'Home District' include those who are undergoing training during 'Probation Periods' &amp; not confirmed in cadre of 'P.S.I.'. These are in respect of Applicants in O.A. No. 284/2024 and O.A. No. 291/2024, O.A. No. 354/2024. In addition he states that in case of few Applicants as in O.A. No. 285 of 2024 they had earlier completed tenure 3 Years in last 4 Years in establishment of 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai'; but have again been transferred back to establishment of 'Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai'.</p> <p>5. Learned Advocate for Applicant further also states that the (i)'Commissioner of Police, Pune and (ii)'Commissioner of Police, Pimpri-Chinchwad' taking into due consideration that large number vacancies in post of 'P.S.I.' and 'A.P.I' in 'Functional Departments' exists even today: have again requested 'D.G.P., Maharashtra State' to keep them vacant till completion of 'General Elections to Lok Sabha: 2024'. However, this contention is negated by P.O. along with 'Law Officer' of 'D.G.P., Maharashtra State' who state that no such request has yet been received from (i)'Commissioner of Police, Pune' and (ii)'Commissioner of Police, Pimpri Chinchwad'.</p> <p>6. The proposition of learned Advocate for Applicants that grievances of Applicants which also relate to implementation of provisions of law under 'Section 22(N)' of 'Maharashtra Police Act 1951' and consideration of 'Administrative Guidelines' of Home Department be heard on merit is thus acceptable because all Applicants have now agreed to forthwith join on their new posts as per Transfer Order dated 26.02.2024 of 'DGP, Maharashtra State'. Hence, orders of 'Interim Relief' if any; granted to 'P.S.I.' and 'A.P.I' serving on establishments of (i) 'Commissioner of Police, Pune' (ii) 'Commissioner of Police, Pimpri-Chinchwad' now stands vacated: so as to facilitate immediate implementation of 'Transfer Order' dated 26.02.2024 of 'DGP, Maharashtra State'.</p> <p>7. Till such time, Applicant is allowed to work in 'Control Room' on establishment of 'Commissioner of Police, Nahsik'.
