- 2. having heard the matter for quite some time, it is noticed that the basic grievance of the Applicant pertains to shifting of his name in the select list for promotion to the post of Assistant Commissioner, Sales Tax though the prayer in O.A. pertains to rejection of his representation for upgradation of ACR for the year 1995-1996 and 1997-1998.
- The Applicant joined as Sales Tax Officer (Class-I) on 23.06.1995. Later, by order dated 26.12.2002, he was promoted as Assistant Commissioner of Sales Tax (redesignated as Deputy Commissioner of Sales Tax) that time obviously he was promoted on the basis of ACR of previous 5 years. However, later the Respondents in view of directions given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Civil Appeal No.5582/1998 (Dinkar Anna Patil & Anr. V/s State of Maharashtra & Ors decided on 09.11.1998, the Hon'ble Supreme Court directed for fresh seniority list for promotees and nominees on the basis of date of appointment of respective Sales Tax Officers, Class-1 in that cadre ignoring the period during which the private Respondents and other similarly situated Sales Tax Officers, Class-I were appointed on fortuitous basis. The Hon'ble Supreme Court observed that date of regularization shall be the relevant date for the purpose of fixing the inter se seniority of promotees and nominees. It is in pursuance of the direction given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, fresh exercise was carried out to prepare the seniority list and select list afresh. While doing so, the Respondents shifted the seniority of the Applicant

w.e.f. 01.01.2004 and his date of absorption is shown

10.10.2003. Accordingly, the seniority was published on 21.01.2015.

- 4. The Applicant made representation objecting his downgrading in seniority list dated 21.01.2015 and requested that his seniority be shown immediately below one Shri Girish Nehate and above one Sri Tejrao Pacharne. At the same time, he also made representation for upgradation of his ACR for the year 1995-996, 1996-1997 and 1999-2000 as 'Outstanding' in place of 'Good'. The representations are at page nos.94 to 104 of PB.
- 5. The Government, however, rejected his representations for upgradation of ACR by order dated 03.10.2019.
- 6. In O.A., the Applicant has challenged communication dated 03.10.2019.
- 7. As such, the real grievance of the Applicant is about shifting of his placement in seniority list. In prayer clause, the Applicant has also prayed for upgradation of ACR with consequential service benefits. Thus, apparently the main grievance of the Applicant is about change in placement in seniority list.
- 8. In view of above, the subject matter of placement in seniority list pertains to Division Bench. In present case, *prima-facie*, the matter pertains to Division Bench.
- 9. Insofar as communication of ACR which are 'Good' are concerned, as per G.R. the then prevailing, there was no necessity to communicate the ACR if gradation is 'Good'. This being the position, the ground raised by learned Counsel for the Applicant that Applicant was not communicated ACR of relevant years which were 'Good' and, therefore, he could not make representation for upgradation is hardly of any significance. Thus, the main grievance boiled down to placement in seniority irrespective of the reason be it due to ACR or direction of Hon'ble Supreme Court.
- 10. The Registrar is, therefore, directed to examine the matter and place it before the Division Bench.
