4. None present on behalf of Respondent No.10. There is no Noting of 18.04.2024. The matter was last heard on 18.04.2024. Shri Shrikant Kadam, Sheristedar informs that the matter was adjourned on 18.04.2024.

5. The learned Advocate for Applicant submits that Shri M.D. Lonkar had appeared for Respondent No.10 in this matter and this matter was tagged along with OA 293/2024 where Respondent No.10 in this OA No.483/2024 is Respondent No.8 and Shri Prashant Patil, learned Advocate appeared in that matter for Respondent No.8.

6. The Civil Surgeon, Nashik who is party Respondent No.7 is directed to file his say about the 'Disability Certificate' issued to Respondent No.10.

7. It is made clear that if appointment is made to Respondent No.10, it will be subject to outcome of this OA and that is to be mentioned if appointment order is issued to him.
