ORDER

1. Heard Mrs. Punam Mahajan, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Mr. A.J. Chougule, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

2. It is the contention of the Applicant that he has been promoted as a Deputy Commissioner and posted as Deputy Commissioner (Establishment) in the Office of Social Welfare Commissioner, Pune by order dated 28.12.2016. It is further contention of the Applicant that he has not completed normal tenure of his posting. But he has been abruptly transferred and posted as Deputy Commissioner (Planning) in the same office by impugned order dated 6.9.2018. It is his contention that his transfer is made in violation of Section 4(4)(ii) and 4(5) of the Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as "Transfer Act) with intention to accommodate private Respondent No.2 at his place.

3. Learned Advocate for the Applicant has submitted that the impugned order by which the Applicant has been transferred is a mid-term transfer order and the Respondents have not followed the provisions of Section 4(4)(ii) and 4(5) of the Transfer Act while issuing the impugned order. She has submitted that no specific reasons has been recorded while issuing the impugned order.
4. Learned Advocate for the Applicant has further submitted that the work of the Applicant is excellent and there is no complaint against him. She also submitted that the Applicant has not been relieved till today and he is still working on the same post. Therefore, she requested to grant interim relief as prayed for.
5. Learned P.O. has submitted that the transfer of the Applicant has been made as per the recommendation of the Civil Services Board and with the approval of the higher competent transferring authority and there is no illegality in it. He has also produced the documents regarding the transfer of the Applicant for perusal of the Tribunal. He has submitted that, he has no instruction regarding relieving of the Applicant.
6. On perusal of the record, it reveals that the private Respondent Shri Ghule who is serving at Aurangabad and one Shri Wagh who is serving at Pune have filed request applications for making their transfers by mutual consent. The requests of Shri Ghule and Shri Wagh have been accepted by the Civil Services Board and accordingly, the recommendation was made. While submitting the said proposal, the concerned Department has proposed the transfer of the Applicant. No special reasons for transfer of the Applicant has been recorded.
7. Prima-facie, it seems that the impugned order has been issued in contravention of the provisions of Section 4(4)(ii) and 4(5) of the Transfer Act. Till today, the Applicant has not been relieved.
8. In the circumstances, it is just to direct the Respondents to maintain status quo as on today until further orders.
9. Hence, Respondents are directed to maintain status-quo as on today so far as the Applicant is concerned till filing of reply by them.

1. Heard Shri A.V Bandiwadekar, learned advocate for the Applicant, Ms Swati Manchekar, learned Chief Presenting Officer for the Respondents no 1 & 3 and Shri D.B Khaire, learned advocate for Respondent no. 2.
2. This Misc Application was heard yesterday and after hearing, O.A was adjourned at the request of Shri Bandiwadekar, learned advocate for the applicant, today for enabling the advocate to consult the applicant as to whether O.A be withdrawn.
3. Shri Bandiwadekar, learned advocate could not reach when the matter was called out. However, the applicant is present.
4. The applicant asserts that he wants to press this Misc Application.
5. By this application, the applicant wants to challenge his transfer from his last posting as A.C.P, Control Room, Navi Mumbai Commissionerate to A.C.P, Mumbai.
6. Learned Advocate Shri Bandiwadekar has later on appeared and by changing stand urged that he wants to press the M.A and wants to rely on the order passed by Division Bench of Hon'ble High Court in W.P 5933/2004 dated 1.3.2005 and that the prayer for amendment cannot be rejected.
7. Applicant's transfer from the A.C.P, Turbhe Division to Control Room, Navi Mumbai Police Commissionerate is already under challenge in O.A 136/2018 and that matter is being examined, unlike in W.P

6933/2004 where due to subsequent transfer this Tribunal had rejected the O A.


3. Moreover, in W.P 6933/2004 Hon'ble High Court had left the matter of amendment to be decided by this Tribunal in the event application for amendment is eventually filed. There is no judicial mandate ordered in W.P 6933/2004 that application for amendment must be allowed. Moreover, O.A 136/2018 is still pending rather it is not dismissed due to subsequent transfer.

9. The transfer order dated 20.6.2018 is a fresh cause of action which is distinct and independent from the case subject matter of challenge in O.A 136/2018.

10. Hence, Misc Application for amendment is rejected.

11. This does not preclude the applicant from challenging the order dated 20.6.2018 by filing independent Original Application.

12. Original Application No. 136/2018 shall come up for hearing in due course.

ORDER

1. Heard Shri Sachin P. Salunkhe, Power of Attorney of the applicant in person and Ms Savita Suryavanshi, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
2. The Applicant has moved the present Original Application for speaking to the minutes on the ground that the matter was not taken up for hearing by Hon'ble Member (A).
3. Party in person was called to state as to whether he is ready for final hearing of the case. He agreed that he would not insist on speaking to the minutes and shall argue the case for final hearing.
4. Case is taken up for final hearing. The applicant points out that the impugned order No. 11/Estt-4/Appeal/2014/726/337 dated 8.3.2015, page 20, Exh. A as well as impugned communication No. 1/Estt-4/Appeal/204/1779/1013 dated 30.7.2016, page 42, Exh. D,



are de hors the finding recorded in O.A 98/2010, wherein Division Bench of this Tribunal categorically held that Respondents had on record and had knowledge about the fact that applicant had proceeded on maternity, and also that she had submitted application.

5. Applicant has also pointed out that the averments contained in para 5.20 wherein the version contained in both impugned letters is challenged on the ground of it being factually incorrect.

6. The averments contained in para 6.20 of O.A are not dealt with in reply rather reply to specific averment is avoided thereby facts stated in para 6.20 of O.A s and admitted.

7. Prima facie the factual correctness of the matter is not open for adjudication being governed by the findings recorded in para nos 12 & 13 of the judgment of this Tribunal in O.A 98/2010.

8. Initially this Original Application was heard yesterday in the morning session and was adjourned for enabling the Director, Vocational Education to appear in person to explain the situation in which the judicial pronouncement recorded in O.A 98/2010 is open for debate in absence of which impugned communication may amount to contempt.

9. Yesterday, at the request of learned P.O, hearing was deferred and adjourned to afternoon session. Thereafter, the case was called out, in afternoon session. At that time learned P.O accompanied by Shri R.S. Sonawale, Assistant Director, (Non-Technical), was present. Learned P.O has reported on instructions that the Director is out of India and Joint Director, did not arrive, because he did not receive correct message from learned P.O, Ms Suryavanshi, nor that he is formally put in to the charge of the post of Director.

10. Today Shri A.M Jadhav, I/C Director & Shri P.M Wakde, Joint Director, Directorate of Vocational Education & Training, Mumbai are present. He was asked to read out para 12 and 13 of the judgment in

O.A 98/2010. Shri A.M Jadhav, states that it prima facie appears that this Tribunal has taken cognizance of the fact that present applicant had intimated that she was on maternity leave, and her request was to be decided by the appellate authority.

11. Shri A.M Jadhav, was called to state as to whether in the back ground of judicial pronouncement, it is open to the Respondents to urge to the contrary to what the judicial pronouncement is. At this stage, he prays for time to take corrective measures.


12. It was clarified that corrective measures would mean accepting the fact that applicant had proceeded on maternity leave and that her leave needs to be dealt with in accordance with rules, if required by permitting the applicant to take measures for rectification of deficiency, if any, in relation to earlier leave application.

13. It implies that applicant shall cooperate.

14. In view that Learned Presenting Officer has prayed for time for re-examining the matter and for reporting substantial compliance,, time is granted till 25.09.2018 with a hope that Respondents would not aggravate the matter and would take proper and prudent steps for effectively implementing the judgment and order passed in O.A 98/2010.

15. S.O to 25.10.2018.

16. Steno copy and Hamdast is granted. Learned P.O is directed to communicate this order to the Respondents.




3. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal need not be issued.
4. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
5. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
6. The service may be done by hand delivery/ speed post/courier and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file affidavit of compliance and notice.
7. In case notice is not collected within three days and service report on affidavit is not filed three days before returnable date, OA shall stand dismissed without reference to Tribunal and papers be consigned to record.
8. Ld. Advocate for the applicant refers to the order dated 31.8.2018 passed by the Hon'ble Chairman in OA No.734 of 2018 & Ors. granting interim relief to all who are in similar situation like applicant. The applicant is a Scientific Officer and was having contract to work up to 3.9.2018. The Ld. Advocate further mentions that even then applicant is continuing to work. Similar relief as in the order of 31.8.2018 is extended to the applicant in the present OA as well. The same terms and conditions will apply to him.
