2. In the present O.A., the challenge is to the suspension order dated 16.07.2018. Earlier the Applicant has filed O.A.No.127/2019 which was decided by this Tribunal on 22.02.2019 whereby directions were given to take review of suspension in terms of G.R. dated 14.10.2011 and also to complete the D.E. within four months from the date of order.

3. The Government has taken review of the suspension and decided not to revoke the suspension.

4. In so far as directions for completion of D.E. is concerned, it is not completed within stipulated time granted by the Tribunal.

5. Today, learned P.O. submits that inquiry is completed and the report is submitted. He further stated that show cause notice is also issued to the Applicant and final order in D.E. will be passed soon. He, therefore, requested for grant of time.

6. Learned Counsel for the Applicant has pointed out that the Applicant has received the report of enquiry officer on 30.08.2019 to which the Applicant has submitted his reply on 03.09.2019. Thus, enquiry is already completed and pending at the stage of passing final order.

7. In view of above, present O.A. can be disposed of with suitable directions as D.E. is on the verge of completion.

8. Respondent is directed to pass final order in D.E. in accordance to rules within four weeks from today.

9. If the final order is not passed within four weeks from today, the suspension of the Applicant will be deemed to be revoked and the Applicant will be entitled for reinstatement in service, subject to further outcome of D.E..

10. Original Application is disposed of with no order as to costs.

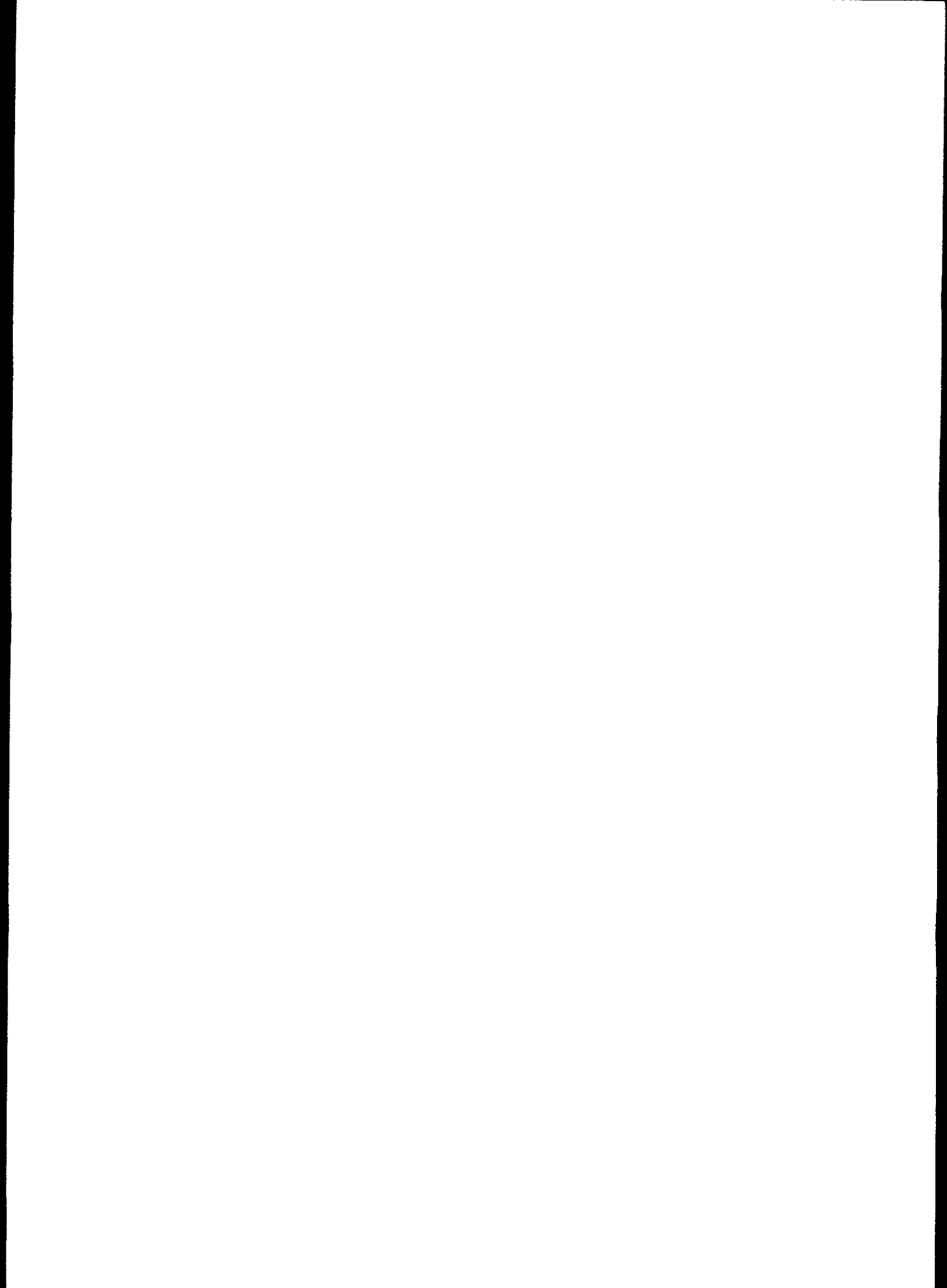

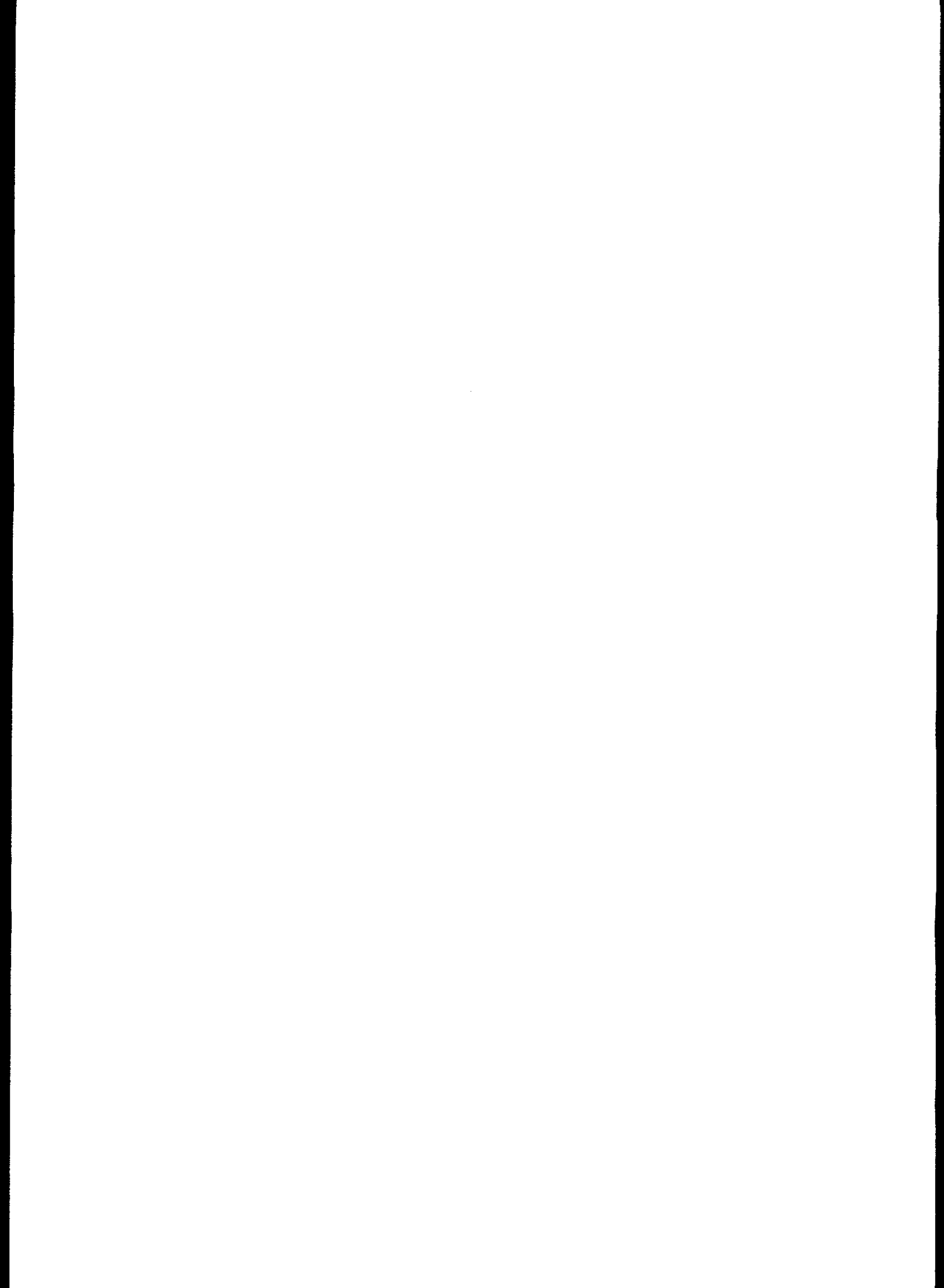
