

9. The suspension of the Applicant is already revoked and he is reinstated in service, the grievance of prolong suspension raised by the Applicant stands redressed and no more survives.
10. Respondents are directed to ensure completion of D.E. within six months from today in accordance to rules.

O.A. has been filed with the prayer made to quash the orders issued by the Inspector General of Registration and Controller of Stamps, Maharashtra State dated 13.09.2007 and appellate order by the State Government on 13.02.2008. The M.A., according to the Applicant is filed for condonation of delay of 7 years.

4. Respondents have filed affidavit-in-reply. In addition to the affidavit, learned P.O. also produces communication dated 27.08.2018 addressed to the Applicant. According to this communication an amount of Rs.82,800 was refunded to the applicant on 16.09.2008. After the expiry of punishment, on 01.06.2010 he was again promoted and his pay was fixed followed by the verification. He has been paid retirement benefits due to him and no amount is pending.

5. Respondents submit that the impugned orders are issued in the year 2007 and 2008 and there is delay of more than 11 years in approaching this Tribunal and hence O.A. be dismissed.

6. Applicant is present in person and has no explanation to contest the same. After the impugned orders, applicant was in service till 30.06.2012. O.A. is therefore hopelessly time barred, since it is filed after 11 years. He also does not furnish sound reasons to explain the delay.

7. Hence, I find no reason to consider the prayer made by the Applicant. In view of the same M.A. is rejected. Consequently, O.A. also stands dismissed. No order as to costs.
