However, now it transpired that the Regional Transport Office, Nanded did not serve the order of punishment dated 30.8.2019 on the applicant.</p> <p>2. We consider it that the date of service of order of punishment dated 30.8.2019 on the applicant is when the affidavit in reply dated 5.8.2021 is filed by the Respondents along with copy of order of punishment. Hence, the date of knowledge and service of order of punishment dated 30.8.2019 on the applicant is 5.8.2021.</p> <p>3. Learned counsel for the applicant states that the appeal against the said order lies before His Excellency The Governor of Maharashtra and seeks permission to withdraw the Original Application with liberty.</p> <p>4. We make it clear that the period from 5.8.2021, the date on which the affidavit in reply was filed, till today is to be excluded under Sec 14 of the Limitation Act from the computation of period of limitation. We also further clarify and direct the Respondents that the applicant is to be paid the pension after deducting 10% of the amount of pension for 10 years as per the order of punishment dated 30.8.2019, till it is set aside by the Appellate Authority.</p> <p>5. In view of the above, Original Application is allowed to be withdrawn with liberty. In this Original Application 812/2017, Misc Application No. 89/2021 is filed seeking condonation of delay of 5 years and 7 months.</p> <p>3. It is, therefore, necessary to put up certain facts and developments. The applicant has challenged the Departmental Enquiry. The D.E was initiated against him by issuing charge sheet on 4.1.2011. The Departmental Enquiry report holding him guilty was issued on 19.1.2012. The applicant retired on 31.5.2014. The punishment order directing to reduce 10% pension for 10 years was passed on 30.8.2019. The applicant has filed the present Original Application on 28.8.2017, when the final order of punishment dated 30.8.2019 was not passed.</p> <p>4. However, the applicant has challenged the D.E initiated against him on 4.1.2011. Therefore, he himself has calculated the delay of 5 years and 7 months in filing the present O.A 812/2017.</p> <p>5. Pending the Original Application, the order dated 30.8.2019 was passed by the Respondents. When this Original Application came up for hearing, learned P.O has pointed out the objection raised that it is not maintainable due to delay and latches.</p> <p>6. Learned counsel for the applicant thereafter filed the present Misc Application 89/2021 on 22.2.2021, seeking condonation of delay.</p> <p>7. Learned P.O has filed affidavit in reply on behalf of the Respondents on 5.8.2021, along with order of punishment dated 30.8.2019. The applicant has taken stand that this order of punishment was never served on him and therefore, now he wants to amend the Original Application, by challenging the order of punishment dated 30.8.2019.</p> <p>8. However, learned counsel for the applicant states that there is provision for the applicant to file appeal before His Excellency The Governor of Maharashtra against the order of punishment dated 30.8.2019.</p> <p>9. It is to be noted that against the order of punishment dated 30.8.2019, appeal lies before His Excellency The Governor of Maharashtra. 


