- The applicants are working as Spraying Workers in Pune. Their services are regularized by order dated 31.3.2015 issued by respondent no.1. Ld. Advocate for the applicants submits that the dates of initial appointment of the applicants are 31.3.1994, 28.9.1993 and 31.3.1994 respectively. All these applicants have completed successfully training as Multi-purpose Health Workers. Ld. Advocate for the applicants submits that similarly placed Spraying Workers who were regularized on 31.3.2015 have filed OA No.316 of 2017 and by judgment and order dated 2.11.2018 those applicants were given consequential service benefits pursuant to GR dated 31.3.2015 i.e. from regularization. Ld. Advocate for the applicant submits that case of these 3 applicants is covered under the same order and same benefits are to be given to these applicants. Ld.. Advocate for the applicants points out the affidavit in reply dated 7.3.2019 filed by Dr. Ajay Shankar Bendre, District Malaria Officer, Pune.
- 3. A query is made to the Ld. PO, whether the said judgment and order dated 2.11.2018 passed in OA No.316/2017 is challenged before the Hon'ble High Court or it is implemented. Ld. PO on instructions from Public Health Department informs that said order is not challenged but it is implemented. Hence, further query is made as to what stand is taken in this OA based on the said order in affidavit dated 7.3.2019.

#### Tribunal's orders

- 4. Ld. PO draws our attention to para 29 of the said reply where a reference of the order in OA No.316/2017 is made. It is further mentioned that Legal Cell is studying the order and likely to challenge in due course of time. As the affidavit was filed in March, 2019 and today we are in October, 2023, we would like to know whether the order was challenged or not. Ld. PO on instructions informs that the said order is not challenged till today.
- 5. In view of this as the applicants are similarly placed with that of applicants in OA No.316/2017 the issue of granting them consequential benefits is not res integra. We have to follow the order passed by the earlier Bench as it holds the field as of today.
- 6. So in view of the ratio laid down in (2015) 1 SCC 347 State of Uttar Pradesh & Ors. Vs. Arvind Kumar Srivastava & Ors. we allow this OA and direct the respondents to regularize the services of the applicant from their initial date of appointment along with all consequential service benefits. No order as to costs.

- 2. Learned Advocate for the Applicant states that Applicant who is Live Stock Development Officer has been transferred by Animal Husbandry and Dairy Development Department's Order dated 05.10.2023 from the Deputation Post of 'Head of Department' BARTI, Pune. She states that the Applicant had been initially sent on the 'Deputation Post' of 'Head of Department, BARTI' for One Year by order dated 26.08.2022 of Social Justice & Special Assistance Department with concurrence of the Animal Husbandry Department & Dairy Development; as per provisions of Maharashtra Civil Services (Joining Time, Foreign Service and Payments during Suspension, Dismissal and Removal), Rules, Subsequently, Animal Husbandry and Dairy Development Department vide order dated 29.09.2022 recalled him from his post of 'Head of Department, BARTI' along with other officers on grounds of 'Administrative Exigencies' arising from the spread of 'Lumpy Skin Disease'. Subsequently, Social Justice & Special Assistance Department again by order dated 13.02.2023 sent the Applicant back to the 'Deputation Post' held earlier by him of 'Head of Department, BARTI' for the period of Two Years. Thereafter, the Animal Husbandry and Dairy Development Department by order dated 05.10.2023 has again recalled the Applicant from the post of 'Head of Department, BARTI' on grounds of 'Administrative Exigencies'

arising from spread of 'Lumpy Skin Disease'.

#### 's orders

- Learned Counsel for the Applicant further states that 3. Applicant has been sent to the 'Deputation Post' of 'Head of Department, BARTI, Pune' by Social Justice & Special Assistance Department on two occasions and recalled on two occasions by the Animal Husbandry & Dairy Development Department. Therefore, she stated that the Applicant prays that the order of Social Justice Department dated 13.02.2023 which allowed the Applicant to serve on 'Deputation Post' of 'Head of Department, BARTI, Pune' for Two Years be implemented and stay granted to the order of Animal Husbandry & Dairy Development Department dated 05.10.2023. Further, learned Advocate of the Applicant also points out that order of Animal Husbandry & Dairy Development Department dated 05.10.2023 has been issued without observing provisions of Rule 40 of Maharashtra Civil Services (Joining Time, Foreign Service and Payments during Suspension, Dismissal and Removal), Rules, 1981 and in contravention of the guidelines in G.A.D. G.R. dated 16.10.2018 emphasizing on the requirement of Three Months which was required to be given the Applicant.
- 4. Learned P.O. has argued that the order of Applicant has been issued by Animal Husbandry & Dairy Development Department on 05.10.2023 in its capacity of 'Cadre Controlling Authority' of Live Stock Development Officers and on the ground that there is 'Administrative Exigencies' on account of spread of 'Lumpy Skin Disease'. Learned P.O. produces 'File Noting' of Social Justice Department. She further states that several officers of the cadre of Live Stock Development Officer' have also been recalled and many others proposed to be recalled alongwith the Applicant by the Animal Husbandry & Dairy Development Department.
- 5. The perusal of 'File Noting' of the Social Justice & Special Assistance Department makes it evident that the order of Applicant issued on 13.02.2023 by Social Justice & Special Assistance Department was with the prior approval of 'Hon'ble Chief Minister' who is also the

'Minister in Charge' of the Social Justice Department: although no concurrence had been taken from the 'Minister in Charge' of 'Animal Husbandry and Dairy Development Department'. The order of Animal & Dairy Development Department of 05.10.2023 on the other hand has been issued with approval of the Minister in Charge of the Animal Husbandry & Dairy Development Department. However, as it is imperative to maintain the sanctity of administrative hierarchy in decision making and considering the fact Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 designates the 'Hon'ble Chief Minister' as the 'Competent Authority' to take decisions in respect of transfer of all Government Servants above certain Pay Scales as well as in cases of 'Mid-Term Transfers' which requires 'Ministerin-Charge' of Administrative Department to take prior approval from the 'Hon'ble Chief Minister' as 'Next Higher Authority'; the Animal Husbandry Department's order dated 05.10.2023 should have been issued after submitting the proposal to the 'Hon'ble Chief Minister' particularly because he had approved the earlier proposal of Social Welfare & Special Assistance Department to send the Applicant to the Deputation Post of 'Head of Department, BARTI' for Two Years.

6. The fact and circumstances of the case also highlights the lack of desirable degree of Coordination interface between the Animal Husbandry & Dairy Development Department and Social Justice & Special Assistance Department. The order of Social Justice Department dated 13.02.2023 which was issued after approval of by the

#### "s orders

'Hon'ble Chief Minister' who is Minister in Charge of Social Justice & Special Assistance Department was required to be duly considered by the 'Minister in Charge' of 'Animal Husbandry Department' before granting approval to issue the order dated 05.10.2023. The Animal Husbandry and Dairy Development Department is therefore advised to reconsider the order of the Applicant issued on 05.10.2023 and bring it to the notice of 'Minister in Charge' Animal Husbandry Department that the earlier order of Social Justice & Special Assistance Department dated 13.02.2023 had been issued with approval of 'Hon'ble Chief Minister'. Thereupon an appropriate decision may be taken afresh; about the continuation of the Applicant on the 'Deputation Post' of 'Head of Department, BARTI' otherwise but with the approval of Hon'ble Chief Minister. Till such time, the Animal Husbandry & Dairy Development Department order dated 05.10.2023 shall not be brought into implementation by both the Social Justice & Special Assistance Department and Animal Husbandry Diary Development Department and the Applicant be permitted to join back on the 'Deputation Post' of 'Head of Department, BARTI, Pune'.

- 3. The office objections, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.
- 4. Issue notice before admission returnable on 12.10.2023.
- 5. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondent intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Private service is allowed. Respondents are put to notice that the case may be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

#### Tribunal's orders

- 6. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
- 7. By Hand delivery, speed post, courier notice to be served and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.
- 8. In case notice is not collected within <u>seven</u> days or service report on affidavit is not filed <u>three</u> days before returnable date, the Original Application shall be placed on board before the concerned Bench under the caption "for Dismissal" and thereafter on the subsequent date the Original Application shall stand dismissed.
