Learned Advocate for the applicant adverts our attention towards Annexure 'A-13', page-58 and submits that since the respondent No. 2 has now rejected the claim of the applicant for grant of benefit of Assured Career Progression Scheme, the present O.A. would be within limitation. In the circumstances, issue notices to the respondents, returnable on 23.01.2019.
- 3. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at once and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
- 4. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on respondent/s intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of the case. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
