Ghule Patil, learned Advocaet for the respondent Nos.81 to 84 in M.A.No.206/2020 and Shri S.D. Joshi, leanred Advocate for the respondent Nos.102 to 105 in M.A.No.206/2020.



2. The Misc. Application No.524/2022 is made on behalf of the original respondent Nos.1 and 8 in O.A.No.1100/2019 seeking to vacate order of interim relief dated 03.08.2020 passed in M.A.No.206 of 2020 (M.A.St.No. 625/2020) taken out by the original applicants. The said interim relief order is as follows:-

*“In the meanwhile respondent Nos.1 to 7 should maintain status quo so far as the promotions on the post of Tahsildar from the cadre of Naib Tahsildars, who are appointed after September, 2012.”*

3. According to these original respondent Nos.1 and 8, during pendency of the Original Application grievances of original applicants were considered and G.R. dated 10.05.2021 was issued and final seniority list dated 17.08.2020 was prepared. The said seniority list is now State wide. In view of that, according to these original respondent Nos.1 and 8, interim relief order is required to be recalled or modified.

4. Learned Advocate for the original applicants submits at whose instance the interim relief order

was passed has no objection for vacating interim relief. He further submits that vacating of the interim relief order is not going to affect the hearing of the Original Application as the prayers thereof are for preparing State wide seniority list w.e.f. 01.01.2010. The joint seniority list is however prepared w.e.f. 01.01.2015.

5. Respective learned Advocates appearing for private respondents submitted that appropriate order may be passed.

6. In the circumstances as above, in our considered opinion, vacating interim relief order would facilitate the Government to take appropriate steps in accordance with law as regards the promotion in the cadre of Tahsildar. Hence following order:-

**ORDER**

- (i) Misc. Application No.524/2022 is allowed.
- (ii) Interim relief order dated 03.08.2020 passed in M.A.No.206 of 2020 is hereby vacated.

- (iii) Accordingly, M.A.No.206/2020 also stands disposed of without any order of costs.
- (iv) Affidavit in reply filed on behalf of the respondent Nos.102 to 105 in O.A.No.1100/2019 is taken on record and copy thereof has been served on the side. The applicant is at liberty to file affidavit in rejoinder if any.
- (v) The Misc. Application No.25/2021 and O.A.No.1100/2019 to come on board for hearing on 09.01.2023.
