No.854/2023 which were filed on 08.07.2023 were taken up for expeditious hearing so as to redress the grievances of Applicants who are 'Husband' and 'Wife' and seek transfer to posts of 'L.D.O's' in 'Pune District' having served for more than 10 years on posts of 'L.D.O's' in 'Kolhapur District'.</p> <p>3. The Applicants had submitted representation to 'Principal Secretary Animal Husbandry, Dairy Development and Fisheries Department' on 01.05.2023 requesting to be posted on available posts of 'L.D.O's' in (i) Disease Investigation Wing, Pune (ii) Veterinary Biomaterials Manufacturing Institute, Pune and (iii) Animal Husbandry Commissioner's Office, Pune.</p> <p>4. The Applicant had subsequently submitted request letters to 'Hon'ble Minister-in-Charge' of 'Animal Husbandry and Dairy Development Department' on 16.05.2023 and 24.05.2023 seeking transfer to vacant posts of 'L.D.O.'s' in (i) Veterinary Hospital at Baramati in Baramati Tahsil, Pune District (i) Veterinary Dispensary at Pavaid Dalaj in Indapur Tahsil, Pune District (ii) Veterinary Dispensary at Pavaid Nimbuta in Baramati Tahsil, Pune District.</p> <p>5. The requests made Applicants deserves consideration against the backdrop of 'Affidavit-in-Reply' filed by 'Sr. Administrative Officer' from the</p>

	<p>office of Regional Joint Commissioner 'Animal Husbandry' on 01.12.2023 in response to directions given during the course of hearing in cases relating to transfer of 'L.D.O.'s in Pune Division.</p> <p>6. The disclosures made on repeated persuasion about how many transfer were effected during 'General Transfer: 2023' of 'L.D.Os' in 'Pune District' which had resulted in transfer of those 'L.D.Os' going out of Pune District; the information now revealed by way of 'Affidavit-in-Reply' dated 19.12.2023 brought to light the extent of skewedness that has occurred by design as it showed that out of 55 transfers of 'L.D.Os' done in 'Pune District' during 'General Transfer: 2023' as many as 52 transfers of 'L.D.Os' were done to only retain them back within 'Pune District' and only 1 transfer each of 'L.D.Os' were done to post them outside to 'Palghar, Raigad and Nashik' Districts. Having 'Lifted the Veil' from such arranged transfers of 'L.D.Os' in 'Pune District' during 'General Transfer: 2023' by no stretch of imagination can the request made earlier by Applicants be now brushed aside on grounds of being unreasonable by Animal Husbandry, Fisheries and Dairy Development Department.</p> <p>7. The 'Animal Husbandry, Fisheries and Dairy Development Department has consistently reiterated 'Administrative Exigency' to be the only ground for transfers of 'L.D.O.'s in Pune Division by relying heavily on large number of vacancies in 'Kolhapur District' which had stood at 49% before 'General Transfers 2023'. The 55 transfers of 'L.D.O.'s done in 'Pune District' has not only 'Lifted the Veil' to expose this expansive form of "Arbitrary Exercise" of 'Statutory Powers' but has brought to light what caused 'Invidious Discrimination' against Applicants as well as many other 'L.D.O.'s'. The contents of 'Affidavit-in-Reply' filed by 'Sr. Administrative Officer' from office of Regional Joint Commissioner 'Animal Husbandry' filed on 01.12.2023 irrefutably establishes the fact that most of 'L.D.Os' have managed to remain within 'Pune District' for continuous periods ranging from 15 to 25 years.</p> <p>8. The Applicants have served together as 'Husband & Wife' for more than 10 years in 'Kolhapur District'. However, fact remains that overwhelmingly much larger number of 'L.D.Os.' have over stayed for extended periods of 15 to 25 years within 'Pune</p>

Hence time is ripe for 'Principal Secretary Animal Husbandry, Dairy Development and Fisheries Department' to act with alacrity and initiate corrective action so that those 'L.D.O's who have unabashedly stayed back for 15 to 25 years within 'Pune District' are now transferred out to serve at least one 'Normal Tenure' of '3 Years' in 'Kolhapur District' or elsewhere in 'Pune Division'.</p> <p>9. The information obtained during hearing indicates post of 'L.D.O.' are available in (i) Veterinary Hospital at Baramati in Baramati Tahsil, Pune District (i) Veterinary Dispensary at Pavaid Dalaj in Indapur Tahsil, Pune District (ii) Veterinary Dispensary at Pavaid Nimbuta in Baramati Tahsil, Pune District.</p> <p>10. The Applicants have been transferred in 'General Transfer 2023' to 'Gadhinglaj & Radhanagari' by Transfer Order dated 15.05.2023 of Animal Husbandry, Fisheries and Dairy Development Department when it was possible to consider their requests as 'Husband and Wife' to be posted together on available posts of 'L.D.O.' in 'Pune District' having served for more than 10 years on posts of 'L.D.O's' in 'Kolhapur District'. Hence, against the back drop enumerated above the requests of Applicant as 'Husband & Wife' deserves to be considered with an 'Open Mind' for transfer to vacant posts of 'L.D.O.'s in (i) Veterinary Hospital at Baramati in Baramati Tahsil, Pune District (i) Veterinary Dispensary at Pavaid Dalaj in Indapur Tahsil, Pune District (ii) Veterinary Dispensary at Pavaid Nimbuta in Baramati Tahsil, Pune District after observing provisions of Section 4(4)(1) read with Section (4)(4)(ii) & Section 4(5) of the 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005' & after appreciating the differentiated status of Applicants as 'Husband and Wife' as per guidelines in 'G.A.D. The 'Principal Secretary, 'Animal Husbandry, Fisheries and Dairy Development Department' is directed to take stringent note of all the observations made above with regard to transfer of 'L.D.O's' in 'Pune District' and issue 'Transfer Orders' of the Applicants together as 'Husband Wife' within 'Four Weeks' from date of uploading of this Order dated 12.01.2024.

13. The O.A. No.853 of 2023 and O.A. No. 854 of 2023 are accordingly disposed off. 'No Order as to Costs'.

Learned P.O. states that procedure in G.A.D. G.R. dated 09.04.2018 was followed for 'General Transfers 2023' of 'Foresters'. She also states that there is an established policy for transfer of employees of 'Forest Department' who are below the level of 'Regional Forest Officer' (RFO). The employees in cadres of (i) 'Forest Guards' and (ii) 'Foresters' are required to be mandatorily posted by rotation from 'Social Forestry' to 'Wildlife Management' to 'Territorial' Branches. She further states these policy guidelines are invariably observed at the time recommendations are made by 'C.S.B. – II'.</p>




