The Applicant challenges the Merit List dated 05.01.2024 published by Respondent No.2 as Respondent No.2 has failed to consider the objections raised by him in respect of (i) Question ID-630680312451 and (ii) Question ID 630680311423.</p> <p>3. Learned Counsel for the Applicant submits that the Advertisement for recruitment for the post of 'Talathi' was published by Respondent No.1 on 26.06.2023. In the said Advertisement, 11 posts are shown to be reserved for EWS category and 46 posts are reserved for 'Open' category. Thereafter, Government of Maharashtra sent revised requisition according to which, Respondent No.2 published revised requisition. According to said requisition, 9 posts are reserved for 'EWS' category and 47 posts are reserved for 'Open' category. Pursuant to Advertisement, Applicant applied for the said post on 01.07.2023 and examination was conducted on 27.09.2023.</p> <p>4. Learned Counsel further submits that 1st 'Response Sheet' was published on 28.08.2023. Respondent No.2 issued a publication on 27.09.2023 thereby stating that the answer key will be published on 28.09.2023 and thereby inviting objections for the answer key. The Applicant raised objections for Question ID-630680312451 and Question ID-630680311423. 5. Learned Counsel for Applicant pointed out that as regards Question ID-630680312451- Q.No.15 , the correct answer is option no.3 i.e 'Article 6' of "The Constitution of India, 1950" which states about 'Rights of Citizenship of certain persons who have migrated to India from Pakistan". As against this, Respondent No.2 has given marks for the wrong answer i.e Option No.1-Article 7 of the Constitution of India which states about "Rights of Citizenship of certain migrants to Pakistan".

6. Learned Counsel further pointed out that in Question ID – 630680311423- Q.No.15, two different speeds have been mentioned of a boat which travels against the flow i.e upstream and with the flow i.e downstream. The Applicant submits that, two different speeds have been mentioned as under :-

Upstream – (i) 4kms in 180 minutes (ii) 8 kms in 240 minutes

Downstream – (i) 8 kms in 180 minutes (ii) 6 kms in 240 minutes.

Therefore, if the speeds vary, in both the directions, then it is impossible to calculate speed of the boat in the steady water. As the Applicant had no option than to choose one of the answers , he chose Option 4 – 3' for which he was given '0' marks. The Applicant claims that question itself was wrongly framed and hence, he ought not to have been given '0' marks.

7. Learned Counsel then submitted that Respondent No.1 published objection redressal summary on 6.12.2023, thereby stating that objections were received by 16.205 candidates for 2831 question out of which, Respondent No.1 held objections of 146 questions as valid and after correcting said 146 questions, published objection redressal summary. He submits that Respondent No.2 again published objection redressal summary on 22.12.2023, in said summary also the objection raised by the Applicant were not considered. Learned Counsel submits that there were three instances of objection redressal but Respondents did not considered the objections raised by Applicant in respect of (i) Question ID-630680312451 and (ii) Question ID 630680311423.

The Applicant came to be transferred to 'Gadchiroli' by 'D.G.P, Maharashtra State' Order dated 30.01.2024. However as of today Applicant continues to work on the post of 'Police Inspector' in 'Control Room' under establishment of 'Commissioner of Police, Thane'.</p> <p>3. Learned Advocate for Applicant emphasized that the issues raised in present O.A. No.194 of 2024 is similar to those in batch of 'O.A. No.144 of 2024 to O.A. No.155 of 2024 with O.A. No.156 of 2024 with O.A. No.161 of 2024' as they all relate to implementation of directions in 'Election Commissioner of India' letter dated 21.12.2023. Thereafter she reiterated the arguments made earlier on 01.01.2024 at the time of hearing of 'O.A. No.114 of 2024, O.A. No.115 of 2024 with O.A. No.122 of 2024' which are in respect to transfer of 'Police Inspectors' under establishment of 'Commissioner of Police, Pimpri-Chinchwad'.</p> <p>4. The 'Home Department' had sought clarifications on 16.01.2024 with regard to directions in 'Election Commission of India letter dated 21.12.2023' from 'Chief Electoral Officer, Maharashtra State'. Subsequently appropriate clarifications came to be</p>

issued by 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 19.01.2024 to 'Chief Electoral Officer, Maharashtra State' in the context of the earlier letter of 'Deputy Secretary' & 'Joint Chief Electoral Officer, Maharashtra State, Mumbai' dated 09.01.2024 in which separate 'Annexure' was attached to indicate the directions in 'Election Commission of India letter dated 21.12.2023' and presumption made by office of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State, Mumbai'. In this 'Annexure' at 'Serial No.5' the presumption made by office of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' was as to whether directions with regard to period of posting of 'Three Years' out of last 'Four Years' were also applicable to 'Police Officers' posted in 'Specialized Agencies' such as 'State Intelligence Department, Crime Intelligence Department, Anti-Terrorist Squad, Protection of Civil Rights, Police Training Centres, Highway Safety Patrols etc.' The presumption of the office of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' therefore was about the extent of interpretation to be made about the phrase 'Functional Departments' used in the context of 'Computerization, Special Branch Training' etc. in 'Para 5.3' of 'Election Commission of India letter dated 21.12.2023'.

5. The 'Election Commission of India letter dated 19.01.2024' addressed to 'Chief Electoral Officer, Maharashtra State' clarifies about these presumptions made by office of 'D.G.P., Maharashtra State, Mumbai' by directing that entire tenure in 'Revenue District' should be counted irrespective of establishments of 'Police Commissioners' or 'Superintendents of Police' or even 'Branch of Posting'. Hence, from the nature of clarifications subsequently issued by 'Election Commission of India' on 19.01.2024 and again on 24.01.2024 regarding the presumption made by office of 'D.G.P., Maharashtra State' it became necessary to seek the presence of 'Deputy Secretary' & 'Joint Chief Electoral Officer, Maharashtra State' to understand as to how these revised directions are to be understood and implemented by 'D.G.P., Maharashtra State' as well as 'Heads of Specialized Agencies' and by all field establishments of (i) 'Commissioners of Police' (ii) 'Special IGP's' and (iii) 'Superintendents of Police'.

6. The 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023 contains set of standard instructions regarding transfers of (i) District Officers (ii) Police

7. By Hand delivery, speed post, courier notice to be served and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.

8. In case notice is not collected within **seven days** or service report on affidavit is not filed **three days** before returnable date, the OA shall be placed on board before the concerned Bench under the caption "**For Dismissal**" and thereafter on the subsequent date the OA shall stand dismissed.


