Learned Advocate for Applicants states that the Applicants who are from cadre of 'Assistant B.D.O' are working in 'Sangli' and 'Satara' districts have been transferred by 'Transfer Order' dated 16.02.2024 of Rural Development and Department' from (a) Sangli to Satara in O.A. No.356/2024 &amp; O.A. No.358/2024 and (b) Satara to Sangli in O.A. No.357/2024.</p> <p>3. Learned Advocate for Applicants states that Applicants have been appointed as (i) 'Sector Officers' by Order of 'District Collectors' &amp; 'D.E.O. Sangli' dated 01.02.2024 in respect of Applicant in O.A. No.356/2024 (ii) 'Sector Officer' by Order of 'District Collectors' &amp; 'D.E.O. Satara' dated 15.02.2024 in respect Applicant in O.A. No.357/2023 and (iii) 'Zonal Officer' by 'Order of S.D.O. Vita, District Sangli' dated 20.12.2023 in respect of Applicant in O.A. No.358/2024.</p> <p>4. Learned Advocate for Applicants states that as per directions in 'Para 6.3' of 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023 those 'Government Servants' who are appointed as 'Sector Officer' / 'Zonal Magistrates' already stand exempted; from transfers yet Applicants have been transferred out from 'Sangli' and 'Satara' Districts by 'Transfer Order'</p>

5. Learned P.O. on basis of information received from officer present from 'Rural Development Department' states that Applicants have been transferred out from 'Sangli' and 'Satara' Districts because at the time of meeting of 'C.S.B.' held on 06.02.2024 they had taken into due consideration the fact that certain election related duties had been assigned to Applicants by 'District Collectors' & 'D.E.O's' of 'Sangli' and 'Satara'. She states that in respect of (a) Applicant in O.A. No.356/2024 was assigned duties relating to 'Training & Publicity' by order of 'District Collector & D.E.O's, Sangli' dated 26.12.2023 (b) Applicant in O.A. No.357/2024 was assigned duty of 'Media Communication' and 'Social Media' by order of 'District Collector & D.E.O's Sangli' dated 08.01.2024 and (c) Applicant in O.A. No.358/2024 was assigned duty of 'Monitoring of MCC' by order of 'District Collector & D.E.O's, Sangli' dated 27.12.2023.

6. The Information which has been made available by learned P.O. on the basis of records produced by officer present on behalf of 'Rural Development Department' indicates that 'Transfer Order' of dated 16.02.2024 of 'Rural Development Department' in respect of Applicants was issued based on nature of election duty assigned to them earlier by 'District Collector & D.E.O's' of 'Satara' and 'Sangli' which have also been so recorded in 'Minutes of Meeting' of 'C.S.B.' held on 06.02.2024. However, it must be observed that 'Rural Development Department' should have re-ascertained the exact nature of duties finally assigned to Applicants as on date of meeting of 'C.S.B.' held on 06.02.2024 as often some changes are made in elections related duties by respective 'District Collectors' & 'D.E.O's'. The Applicants are now assigned work of 'Sector Officers' or 'Zonal Officers'. As 'District Collector & D.E.O's' of 'Sangli' and 'Satara' had issued revised orders prior to meeting of 'C.S.B.' held on 06.02.2024 modifying duties assigned earlier to Applicants to subsequently assign them work of 'Sector Officers' or 'Zonal Officers'. Therefore it was also the responsibility of 'District Collectors & D.E.O's' of 'Sangli'

Learned Advocate for Applicant refers to documents from 'File Notings' of 'Revenue and Forest Department' handed over during hearing on 11.03.2024 and mentions details of various recommendations made for transfer of officers from cadre of 'Tahsildar' by the 'Hon'ble Minister In-Charge of Revenue Department' who is the 'Competent Transferring Authority'.</p> <p>3. Learned Advocate for Applicant thereupon draws attentions to multiplicity of proposals for transfer of officers from cadre 'Tahsildars' including that of Applicant and Respondent No.3 and states that Applicant was initially recommended to be given 'One Year Extension' on post of 'Tahsildar Thane' by 'Hon'ble Minister In-Charge of Revenue Department' which was also approved by 'Hon'ble Chief Minister, Maharashtra State' as next 'Superior Transferring Authority. However, for unknown reasons the 'Revenue and Forest Department' did not issue 'Transfer Order' of Applicant granting him 'One Year Extension' on post of 'Tahsildar Thane'.</p> <p>4. Learned Advocate for Respondent No.3 reiterated that he has joined on post of 'Tahsildar Thane' on 20.02.2024. Therefore Respondent No.3 be permitted to continue because Applicant cannot now serve on post of 'Tahsildar Thane' due to fact that 'Thane District' is his 'Home District' and is also facing</p>

Learned Advocate for Respondent No.3 also submitted copy of Judgment dated 07.12.2016 in Writ Petition No.9499 of 2016 to substantiate that Order dated 15.02.2024 of 'Revenue and Forest Department' to post of Respondent No.3 on post of 'Tahsildar Thane' was for justiciable reasons to hold free and fair 'General Elections to Lok Sabha 2024.</p> <p>6. 	<p>Thane'. The decision so taken by 'Hon'ble Chief Minister of Maharashtra State' was therefore not in accordance with the guidelines of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in (2013) 15 SCC 732 (T.S.R. Subramanian and Ors. Vs. Union of India &amp; Ors.) as no specific reasons were recorded for not accepting the recommendation of 'C.S.B.' and importantly in non-observance of directions in the 'Para 8' of 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023.</p> <p>9. The 'File Notings' of 'Revenue and Forest Department' interestingly also reveal that approval to proposal in File No. नस्ती क्र बदली - २०२४/प्र.क्र.०९/ई-३ which had given given by 'Hon'ble Chief Minister of Maharashtra State' including to transfer Respondent No.3 to post of 'Tahsildar Thane' was actually received back in the office of 'Additional Chief Secretary, Revenue and Forest Department' only on 16.02.2024; but even before it had even reached the table of 'Deputy Secretary' who is 'In-Charge of Desk 3'; the 'Transfer Order' dated 15.02.2024 of 'Revenue and Forest Department' to transfer 'Respondents No.3' on post of 'Tahsildar Thane' had been hurriedly issued for unknown reasons one day earlier on 15.02.2024.</p> <p>10. The above two queries on 'Para 8' and 'Para 9' are required to be forthrightly answered by 'Revenue and Forest Department' with respect to 'Transfer Order' dated 15.02.2024 of 'Respondent No.3' posting of him as 'Tahsildar Thane'. No further observations are thus required to be made at this stage with respect to transfer of 'Applicant' from post of 'Tahsildar in Thane' to the Deputation Post of 'Tahsildar in MMRDA'.</p> <p>11. The State of Maharashtra &amp; Ors. ....Respondents.</p> <p>1. Heard Mr. Kailash Jadhav holding for Mr. R.G. Panchal, learned Counsel for the Applicant and Ms. K.S. Gaikwad, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.</p> <p>2. M.A. is filed seeking stay of impugned order dated 30.06.2023, terminating the services of the applicant, issued without any inquiry or notice. Further, Applicant prays for early date of hearing.</p> <p>3. Learned Counsel Mr. Jadhav prays for interim stay to the order dated 30.06.2023 issued by the Respondent No.2, thereby terminating services of the applicant under Article 311 (2) of the Constitution. He has submitted that the Applicant was working as Clerk-cum-typist in the office of Government Pleader and his service was protected by the Tribunal by order dated 21.09.2021 passed in O.A.No.1105/2016 directing the Respondent No.2 to regularize the service of the present applicants and other applicants working as Clerk-cum-typist w.e.f. 01.10.2021. The State of Maharashtra has challenged the said order before the Hon'ble High Court in Writ Petition No.1231/2022. The Hon'ble High Court by order dated 02.02.2022 has stayed the order of the Tribunal directing that till the said Writ Petition is finally disposed of the Original Applicants (Respondents) shall not be discontinued from service and shall be allowed to work on the same posts and be paid emoluments.</p> <p>4. Thereafter the Hon'ble High Court in Interim Application No.990/2023 in W.P.No.1506/2022 with W.P.No.1506/2022 on 21.04.2023 has passed the following order :</p> <p style="text-align: right;">[P.T.O.]</p>

*"The said order would not preclude the present Applicant/State Authority for initiating the disciplinary proceeding if a misconduct is committed by any of the Respondents or the non-applicant."*

5. Learned Counsel by virtue of this order has submitted that the Government is precluded from terminating the service without initiating the disciplinary proceedings if the misconduct is committed by the Applicant. Thus, the action of the Government terminating the service of applicant amounts to breach of the order of the Hon'ble High Court.

6. Learned P.O. has submitted that the Applicant was not a regular Government servant working in the office of Government Pleader in the Hon'ble High Court, but he was working as temporary staff by way of stop gap arrangement till the selected candidate is appointed. The order of regularization was stayed by the Hon'ble High Court. Applicant was terminated pursuant to the FIR lodged on 07.03.2022 of the theft of office cell phone and subsequently the applicant has confessed about taking away cell phone which was de jure in the possession of Government Pleader.

7. We have gone through the order of termination and it is clear from the order of the Hon'ble High Court that the order of regularization passed by this Tribunal was stayed by the Hon'ble High Court. When act of theft occurred the applicant was working on temporary basis. Thereafter prima facie, this termination in view of the nature of the offence is considered serious and his services were terminated.

8. The submissions of learned Counsel that in the modified order the Hon'ble High Court has stated that the order will not preclude from initiating disciplinary proceeding if misconduct is committed and therefore the action of termination without disciplinary enquiry is illegal or has committed Contempt or breach of the order dated 21.04.2023 of the Hon'ble High Court are not at all acceptable. These submissions are completely fallacious as the order cannot be read and understood by twisting the proposition in the order hence, M.A. stands rejected.

9. As far as second prayer made in M.A. regarding expedite the hearing of O.A. is concern, we make it clear that we cannot expedite the matter as the Tribunal is working with only one judicial matter and has to disposed the matters of the year 2017.

10. M.A. stands rejected.


