In the present matter, the Applicant has challenged his transfer order dated 07.06.2019 on the ground that it is mid-term and mid-tenure transfer in contravention of Section 4(4)(ii) and 4(5) of Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as 'Transfer Act, 2005'.).
- 3. Shri A. V. Bandiwadekar, learned Counsel for the Applicant pointed out that the Applicant was transferred as Store Keeper by order dated 31.05.2016 and not completed normal tenure but he has been transferred by order dated 07.06.2019 only to favour the Respondent No.2 who has been posted in the place of Applicant. He is also pointed out that there is no approval of next higher authority as required under Section 4(5) of the Transfer Act, 2005.
- 4. Per contra, learned P.O. sought to contend that Superintendent Engineer is empowered to transfer the Applicant in terms of notification dated 16.06.2006 and, therefore, with the approval of next higher authority i.e. Chief Engineer, the Applicant has been transferred.
- 5. Learned P.O. further sought to contend that the Applicant has completed more than 6 years of tenure at Mumbai and, therefore, it can't be termed as mid-tenure transfer.
- 6. In so far as completion of normal tenure of the Applicant is concerned, it is clear from order dated 31.05.2018 that the Applicant was posted as Store Keeper in the office of Executive Engineer, PWD, Presidency Division, Mumbai. This being the position, it can't be said that he had completed normal tenure as the period has to be reckoned with form order dated 31.05.2018. As such, prima-facie, the impugned transfer order is mid-term and mid-tenure transfer.

Tribunal's orders

- 7. As per Section 6 of Transfer Act, 2005 for such mid-term and mid-tenure transfer, there has to be approval of next immediate preceding competent authority as mentioned in the table attached to Section 6 of the Transfer Act. Such powers of approval by next competent transferring authority can't be delegated by issuance of notification dated 16.06.2006 without amendment to the Transfer Act, 2005.
- 8. In view of above, I am satisfied that prima-facie the impugned transfer order is in contravention of Section 4(4)(2) and 4(5) of Transfer Act, 2005 and deserves to be stayed.
- 9. For the aforesaid reasons, interim relief is granted to stay the implementation of transfer order dated 07.06.2019.
- 10. In view of above, if the Applicant is already relieved, he be reinstated on the same post.
- 11. Hamdast and steno copy is granted.
- 12. Issue notice before admission returnable on 10.07.2019.
- 13. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
- 14. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A.. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
- 15. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
- 16. The service may be done by Hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.

- 1. Heard Shri A. V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Smt. Kranti Gaikwad, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. In the present matter, the Applicant has challenged the impugned transfer order dated 30.05.2019 contending that it is mid-term and mid-tenure transfer in non compliance of Section 22 (N) (2) of the Maharashtra Police Act. Secondly, it being punitive required to be stayed by way of interim relief.
- 3. Per contra, learned P.O. for the Respondents has pointed out that the Applicant has been transferred in view of default report approved by the Police Establishment Board (PEB) contemplated under Section 22(N) (2) of the Maharashtra Police Act.
- 4. Learned P.O. has tendered a copy of minutes of PEB which shows that the issue of transfer of the Applicant was discussed and found that while serving in control room, the Applicant had disclosed the phone number of the caller and thereby committed mis-conduct and his integrity found suspicious. It is also noted in the minutes that the Applicant had completed near about 17 years of service in Mumbai. The PEB, therefore, thought it appropriate to transfer him to Dhule from the point of administration of the department.
- 5. Suffice to say, *prima-facie*, there is compliance of Section 22(N)(2) of the Maharashtra Police Act which provides that in public interest and on account of administrative exigency, PEB can make mid-term transfer of the police personnel.

Tribunal's orders

- 6. Reliance placed by the learned Counsel on the judgment of the Hon'ble High Court in W.P.No.8437 of 2017 (The Addl. Chief Secretary, Home Department & Anr. V/s Arun R. Pawar), decided on 05.09.2018 is misplaced. In that case, the transfer order was quashed as minutes did not record the reasons for the transfer of the police personnel. In that case, except the names of the officers, their place of original postings and place of proposed postings, nothing has been mentioned about the reasons for the transfer of the mid-term transfer. It is in that context, the transfer order was quashed.
- 7. Whereas in the present case as discussed above reasons are specifically mentioned in the minutes of PEB
- 8. In view of above, I am not inclined to grant interim relief.
- 9. Issue notice before admission returnable on

- 1. Heard Shri K. R. Jagdale, learned Advocate for the Applicants and Shri A. J. Chougule, Smt. Archana B. K. and Smt. Kranti Gaikwad, learned Presenting Officers for the Respondents.
- 2. In all these matters, the Applicants are transferred on the post of Talathi at different districts and are seeking direction for inter division transfer in terms of G.R. dated 03.06.2011.
- 3. It is pointed out by the learned Counsel for the Applicants that on the representations made by the Applicants necessary compliance was got done and the concerned S.D.O. where the Applicants are seeking transfer have also communicated their NOC for transfer of the Applicants on their establishment. However, as the powers of inter division transfer in terms of G.R. dated 03.06.2011 was with the Government, the matters seem to have been stuck up, as no order has been passed by the Government within reasonable time.
- 4. Today, it is pointed out by the learned P.O. that recently the Government by G.R. dated 15.05.2019 have delegated the powers of inter division transfer to the appointing authority i.e. S.D.O. in the matter of Talathi in view of G.R. dated 15.05.2019. Learned P.O. submitted that now the concerned S.D.O. is required to take necessary steps for inter division transfer and to pass appropriate order. He, therefore, requested to dispose of the O.A. with suitable directions.

Tribunal's orders

- 5. Learned Counsel for the Applicants have apprehension that the Applicants again will be required to obtain fresh NOC from the concerned S.D.O. if the process is stated in terms of G.R. dated 15.05.2019. In so far as his apprehension is concerned, the care can be taken by issuing suitable directions for not initiating process afresh as the process has already completed in terms of G.R. dated 03.06.2011 in the sense of calling NOC from the concerned SDO.
- 6. In view of above, it would not be necessary to call for NOC again as the formalities are already completed and those are required to be considered and relied upon by the concerned S.D.O. while passing transfer orders.
- 7. For the reasons stated above, all these Original Applications are disposed of by following directions.

ORDER

- (A) Applications are partly allowed.
- (B) The Respondent is directed to send the proposals received from the concerned districts in respect of inter division transfers of the Applicants to Collector in which district, the Applicants are seeking inter division transfer so that those are decided in terms of recent G.R. dated 15.05.2019 whereby the powers of inter division transfer are delegated to appointing authority.
- (C) It is again made clear that there will be no need to call for fresh NOC from the concerned S.D.O. as those formalities are already completed.
- (D) Appropriate orders upon representations made by the Applicants for inter division transfer be passed within three months from today.
- (E) All these Original Applications are disposed of accordingly with no order as to costs.
