But without considering his choice, the impugned order of general transfer has been issued that too in the month of July, 2019. He has submitted that in view of provision of Section 4(4) of the Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (in short Transfer Act,2005), General Transfer has to be made in the month of April and May only. But the mass transfers have been made in the month of July, which is against the provision of the Transfer Act,

2005. He has submitted that the Applicant has not yet relieved and therefore, he has prayed to grant interim relief against the execution and implementations of the impugned transfer order.

4. Learned C.P.O. for the Respondents has submitted that the impugned order has been issued by the Competent Authority by obtaining approval from the next/higher Competent transferring Authority as required under Section 4(4) and 4(5) of the Transfer Act, 2005 and there is not illegality in the impugned transfer order. He has submitted that the Applicant was due for transfer and therefore, he has been transferred on administrative ground. Therefore, he has prayed to reject the interim relief as prayed for by the applicant.

5. On perusal of documents on record, it reveals that initially the Competent Authority had effected general transfers of LDOs in the State on 31.05.2019, but the said orders had been stayed by the Government. Thereafter, those orders came to be cancelled. The Competent Authority issued fresh transfer orders dated 04.07.2019, which are under challenge. Prima facie. it seems that the recommendations of the Civil Services Board are not considered while issuing the impugned transfer orders. There is nothing on record to show that the reasons in writing have been recorded by the Competent Authority while rejecting the of the Civil Services recommendations Board.

Mass transfer has been effected in the month of July, 2019. The impugned transfer order shows that the said transfer is general transfers. But the mass transfers have been made in the month of July, which is against the provision of the Transfer Act,

2005. He has submitted that the Applicant has not yet relieved and therefore, he has prayed to grant interim relief against the execution and implementations of the impugned transfer order.

4. Learned C.P.O. for the Respondents has submitted that the impugned order has been issued by the Competent Authority by obtaining approval from the next/higher Competent transferring Authority as required under Section 4(4) and 4(5) of the Transfer Act, 2005 and there is not illegality in the impugned transfer order. He has submitted that the Applicant was due for transfer and therefore, he has been transferred on administrative ground. Therefore, he has prayed to reject the interim relief as prayed for by the applicant.

5. On perusal of documents on record, it reveals that initially the Competent Authority had effected general transfers of LDOs in the State on 31.05.2019, but the said orders had been stayed by the Government. Thereafter, those orders came to be cancelled. The Competent Authority issued fresh transfer orders dated 04.07.2019, which are under challenge. Prima facie. it seems that the recommendations of the Civil Services Board are not considered while issuing the impugned transfer orders. There is nothing on record to show that the reasons in writing have been recorded by the Competent Authority while rejecting the of the Civil Services recommendations Board.

//3// O.A. No. 628/2019

Mass transfer has been effected in the month of July, 2019. The impugned transfer order shows that the said transfer is general transfers. Section 4(4) of the Transfer Act 2005 provides that general transfer may be made in the months of April/May. Prima-facie the impugned order is in contravention of the provision of Section 4(4) of Transfer Act, 2005.

6. In these circumstances, in my opinion, the Applicant has made out a strong case for grant of interim relief.

7. In these circumstances, in my opinion, it is just and proper to stay the operation and execution of the impugned order of transfer.

B) The Respondents be directed to undertake the exercise of re-fixation of Pensionable pay taking into consideration pay earned by applicant in last ten months of service and further be directed to sanction all consequential and retiral benefits owing to refixation of pensionable pay."

4. The brief facts of the case as narrated by the learned Advocate for the applicant are that :

i) The applicant was given *ad hoc* promotion to the post of Police Sub-Inspector (Dog Squad) by an order dated 18.12.2007, Annexure 'A-3', page-15 of paper book of O.A.. However, at the relevant time recruitment rules were not finalized;

ii) The applicant was given ad hoc promotion with one day break. The applicant was retired on attaining the age of superannuation on 31.05.2018 and his pension was fixed in the original cadre of Head Constable because of nonregularization of promotion;

iii) Accordingly, he retired and his pension wasfixed in the scale of Head Police Constable.

The Government vide order dated iv) 15.05.2019, which is marked as document 'X', regularized his promotion w.e.f. 1.6.2012. Further, the Government vide corrigendum dated 'Y' 3.5.2019 marked as. regularized his promotion w.e.f. 17.01.2008.

5. In view the above the prayer now left is that his pension be fixed in the scale of PSI.

6. In view of the above, the respondents are directed to submit his revised pension papers and the revised

pension be fixed within a period of three months along with payment of arrears.

7. With the above observations and directions the present Original Application stands disposed of without any order as to costs.
