Therefore Applicant is overdue for transfer as per 'Section 3(1)' of 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005'. Hence, 'Additional Chief Secretary, Public Health Department' is informed to take appropriate decision about representations submitted by Applicant since 23.02.2021 during ensuing 'General Transfer: 2024' and then communicate decision to Applicant within 'Two Weeks'.



