Kadam , learned Counsel for the Applicant and Smt. Archana B. K., learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.</p> <p>2. Today, learned P.O. has tendered Affidavit in Reply of Shri Nand Kumar, Additional Chief Secretary, EGS, Planning Department, Mantralaya, Mumbai. It is taken on record.</p> <p>3. Original Applicant is filed for direction to the Respondents to release retiral benefits which were held up because of punishment in Departmental Enquiries (D.E.).</p> <p>4. Perusal of record and hearing of learned Counsel, it is noticed that the Applicant stands retired from the post of Assistant Director on 31.05.2014. However, three departmental enquires were pending against him at the time of retirement. In one D.E., by order dated 11.06.2018, punishment of 12% deduction in pension per month permanently is imposed. The Applicant has filed appeal against it and it is subjudice.</p> <p>5. However, no final order is passed in remaining two departmental enquiries. Therefore, the Secretary was directed to file Affidavit to explain the delay caused in taking decision D.E. In Affidavit in Reply, the Secretary tried to explain that there were several queries in the matter and it was referred back to Divisional Commissioner. In another matter, the proposal was forwarded to M.P.S.C. recently on 26.07.2022 and the concurrence of M.P.S.C. is awaiting in respect of proposed punishment. In respect of 3rd inquiry, in Affidavit, the Secretary stated that it is now at final stage and the decision will be taken and final order will be passed soon. He stated that due to insufficient staff, the matter could not be processed earliest.</p>

	<p>6. The reasons mentioned for delay is not at all acceptable in terms of various Circulars and G.Rs issued by the Government. It is nothing but lame excuses. The enquiry ought to have been completed within six months or belatedly in a year. However, in present case, for eight years no final order is passed in D.E. which <i>ex-facie</i> shows total negligence, lethargy and inaction on the part of concerned. Rather, this shows bad and sorry state of affairs of the administration. The Additional Chief Secretary, EGS, Planning Department is, therefore, required to look into the matter and to fix the responsibility on the concerned person for such inordinate and huge delay.</p> <p>7. In view of above, Original Application is disposed of with direction to the Respondents to pass final order in pending two departmental enquires within six weeks from today in accordance to law and the decision as the case may be, shall be communicated to the Applicant.</p> <p>8. The Additional Chief Secretary, EGS, Planning Department is also directed to cause inquiry and to fix the responsibility on the concerned person responsible for such huge and inordinate delay for not passing final order in D.E. within reasonable time and compliance report be submitted to the Registrar of this office within three months from today.</p> <p>9. It is because of inordinate and huge and unexplainable delay, the Applicant is deprived of gratuity. Needless to mention, the gratuity cannot be withheld for such a long time of eight years. The blame certainly lies upon the Respondents for not deciding departmental enquires expeditiously, and therefore, if they failed to pass final order in D.E. within six weeks from today, they will have to release gratuity.</p> <p>10. If the final order in D.E. is not passed within six weeks from today, in that event, the Respondents should not withhold gratuity and it should be paid within two weeks thereafter without fail.</p> <p>11. The Applicant can redress his grievance for interest on the delayed payment by availing remedy independently.</p> <p>12. Learned Counsel for the Applicant also raised grievance about the arrears of Pay & Allowances in terms of Pay Fixation order dated 30.11.2016 passed by the Deputy Director, Social Forestry Division, Sangali. Insofar as this issue is concerned, the Respondents are directed to consider the applicant's claim as sanctioned by order dated 30.11.2016 and shall release monetary benefits as per his entitlement, if not paid.</p> <p>13. CPO informs that pursuant to order dated 14.6.2022 passed by this Tribunal in MA No.270 of 2022 in the above OA, DPC was held on 28.7.2022. Ld. CPO submits that there is one more senior person above the applicant and therefore his case was also to be considered by the DPC. Ld. CPO submits that for one post the CRs of 5 persons are called. Therefore it took time to get the CRs ready. The senior person to the applicant and one more person among these 5 have secured the benefit of reservation. Hence, again the seniority was examined and revised as per the provisions of GR dated 7.5.2021 and therefore there was delay in holding the DPC. The report was submitted to GAD on 29.7.2022 and now approval from GAD is awaited.</p> <p>3. Though GAD is not a party before us, we reproduce paras 8 to 11 of the order dated 14.6.2022 passed by this Tribunal and GAD to take note of it as file is before them since 29.7.2022, which reads as under:</p> <p align="center"><i>"8. Since apparently the process of review is delayed due to sheer callousness and inordinate delay on the part of respondents now further steps of holding DPC and passing further orders of promotion is required to be undertaken without loss of further time.</i></p> <p>9. O.A.No.738/2018 is filed by retired Accountant who stands retired on 31.05.2015 seeking directions to the Respondents to release his gratuity of Rs.3,29,670/-. 3. During the pendency of this O.A., the Applicant has filed these two M.As. M.A.No.73/2022 is filed for condonation of delay and also filed M.A.No.225/2022 for amendment in O.A. 4. By amendment, the Applicant sought to challenge the order dated 05.01.2016 (Page No.35 of O.A.) whereby directions were given for recovery of Rs.2,07,977/- towards excess payment made to the Applicant during the period of service. Initially in O.A., no such relief was claimed and simpliciter direction was prayed to release gratuity. 5. The Applicant has filed O.A. on 10.08.2018 but not challenged order dated 05.01.2016. He ought to have filed O.A. within one year up to 05.01.2017. However, O.A. was filed on 10.08.2018. As such, the delay is near about one year and eight months and not two years & two months as calculated in M.A. 6. Be that as it may, since the Applicant is retired Government servant and litigating for directions to release gratuity, I am inclined to condone the delay so as to decide the matter on merit. Non-payment of gratuity, if he found entitled to it in law can be termed recurring and continuous cause of action. 7. The amendment to challenge communication dated 05.01.2016 is also allowed as without deciding legality of recovery order, entitlement of the Applicant to gratuity cannot be determined since gratuity seems to have been withheld on account of recovery. 8. In view of above, both the Misc. Applications are allowed. Amendment in O.A. be carried out within a week. Common order in all M.As made for condonation of delay caused in filling O.A.</p> <p>2. Heard Shri R.M. Kolge, learned Advocate for the Applicant, Smt. K.S. Gaikwad, Smt. Archana B.K. and Shri A.J. Chougule, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.</p> <p>3. The Applicants have filed O.As challenging recovery orders passed by the Respondents. Since O.A. is not filed within the limitation of one year they have filed M.A. for condonation of delay. Some of the Applicants are retired Government servant and others are still in service. The impugned orders of recovery are</p>

of year 2016, 2017 & 2018 therefore delay is from 10 months upto 3 years. Only in one O.A. i.e. O.A. No.386/2021 it is four years.

4. Learned Advocate for the Applicant submits that the Applicants are group 'C' employees and Department wrongly fixed their pay in implementation of 6th Pay Commission in 2006. However, recovery is sought after more than 10 years. He therefore submits that recovery itself is impermissible in view of the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court in *(2015) 4 SCC 334 (State of Punjab and others Vs. Rafiq Masih (White Washer))*. On this line of submission he prayed to condone the delay so as to decide the O.A. on merit.

5. When specific query is raised to learned Advocate for the Applicant as to whether he is challenging recovery only he fairly concedes that challenge is to the extent of recovery orders only and he is not challenging re-fixation of pay and allowance.

6. Per contra, learned P.O. submits that delay is not properly explained and the Applicants though were aware about wrong fixation have not file the O.A. within time.

7. Needles to mention that while deciding the Application of condonation of delay Tribunal should adopt justice orient approach instead on harping on technical thing particularly in the matter of pay and allowance and recovery from retired Government servant. Whether recovery is permissible or otherwise has to be decided on merit.

8. In view of above, in the facts and circumstance all these matters I am inclined to condone delay caused in filling O.A. All M.As are accordingly allowed with no order as to costs.

9. Respondents are at liberty to file Reply to O.A. by next date.

10. O.A. is adjourned to 30.08.2022.

Applicant stands retired on 30.09.2016.</p> <p>3. Delay seems to have been counted from receipt of communication dated 23.09.2021 issued by Respondent No.2. In this communication the Applicant was informed that he was absent from duty for 1703 days unauthorizedly and chargesheet was also issued to him. As per letter, the Applicant accepted his unauthorized absence. In that said letter it is further stated that the Applicant himself did not attended the office to file necessary forms for retiral benefits and he was asked to remain present within 15 days.</p> <p>4. The Applicant then attended the office and submitted necessary documents as seen from his letter dated 28.09.2021. However nothing happened thereafter, and therefore the Applicant has approached this Tribunal.</p> <p>5. Since, the Applicant is retired Government servant and his retiral benefits are not paid, this is a case of recurring and continuous cause of action. Indeed, the Respondents at their own should have processed the matter and granted his benefits as per his entitlement.</p>






