mandatory requirement before issuing the transfer orders under the provisions of Maharashtra Regulation of Transfer and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act ("Transfer Act" for short) and as per the G.R. issued by the General Administration Department dated 09-04-2018. Applicant submits that as choices of the applicant for places of posting has not been taken, the transfer order is bad in law.

3. Learned Advocate for the applicant admits that the applicant has been working at Taluka Sonpeth, Dist. Parbhani continuously since 20-05-2017 and therefore he is due for transfer. However, there is a technical flaw in the procedure followed by the Civil Services Board that the choices had not been taken before transferring the applicant. Further the applicant is due for retirement in next one and half year and he has old aged parents and family members who require immediate medical care. It is admitted position that Medical Officer (Group-B) as well as in-charge of District Tuberculosis Centre both have responsibilities of touring in their respective areas. It is further submitted by learned

Advocate for applicant upon instructions that the applicant has not been relieved following the transfer order dated 09-06-2023 as he is in the court on the first working day after issuance of the impugned order and as such, no one may have joined in his place by one-sidedly taking over.

4. Today, the applicant is present before the Tribunal during the hearing and claims that he has taken leave of absence from duty. However, the applicant has not appended any evidence in this regard and also the details of his past postings in chronological order. The learned Presenting Officer has stated that the applicant has history of approaching the Tribunal challenging transfer orders and getting the transfer orders stayed. Learned P.O. may submit documentary evidence to buttress her statement in this regard.

5. For granting interim relief it is required to ascertain whether the officer posted in place of the applicant has been relieved from his original post and if so, whether, he has already joined at Sonpeth in absence of which, there is a possibility of one of them remaining without any posting leading to

administrative complication in respect of payment of salary and counting continuity of services of one of the two.

6. Learned P.O. has brought to the notice of this Tribunal that the applicant has filed multiple applications seeking relief against the same impugned order dated 09.06.2023. To elaborate, she made mention of M.A.No.241/2023 IN O.A.No.578/2023 (Mumbai Bench) which has been renumbered as O.A.No.436/2023 and the present O.A.No.432/2023. The learned P.O has further claimed that the applicant has filed another M.A.No.241/2023 IN O.A.No.578/2023 (Mumbai Bench) for withdrawal of that O.A., which has been filed on the basis of a different claim which makes it evident that the applicant has been making inconsistent claims. As the applicant has filed M.A. No.241/2023 in O.A.No. 578/2023 for withdrawal of the O.A.No.578/2023, this shows that the applicant has not approached this Tribunal with clean hands.

7. In view of above facts, it prima facie appears that applicant had claimed to be retained on the post of Medical Officer Group-A by filing

O.A.No.578/2023. However, as he is praying for his retention at Sonpeth which has post of Medical Officer Group-B only, therefore, in my view an in-depth examination of facts has to be made pending which status quo as on today afternoon be maintained. In case, the reliever has joined in place of the applicant, then the applicant shall follow the transfer order subject to outcome of the present O.A.s. Respondents shall ensure that because of order of maintaining status quo, no medical officer remains on compulsory waiting.

8. O.A.No.432/2023 filed by the applicant on 12-06-2023 and M.A.No.241/2023 IN O.A.No. 578/2023 (Mumbai Bench) both in respect of transfer order of the applicant dated 09-06-2023 shall be heard together so that preliminary objections raised by the learned P.O. regarding filing of multiple proceedings on mutually conflicting grounds can be decided before proceeding further.

9. Any extension of interim relief in favour of applicant shall be considered upon decision on point mentioned in paragraph 7 above.

10. Issue notices to the respondents, returnable on 19.06.2023.

11. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at once and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.

12. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on respondent/s intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of the case. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

13. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.

14. The service may be done by hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgment be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry before due date. Applicant is directed to file affidavit of compliance and notice.

Heard Shri S.D.Joshi, learned Advocate for the applicant and Smt. Deepali Deshpande, learned Presenting Officer for the respondent authorities.

2. Learned P.O. submits that she needs time to get instructions as the matter has been circulated today itself and copy of Original Application has not been issued to the respondents. On the other hand, learned Advocate for the applicant states that he is out of station during next 3 days and therefore, in the meantime, interim relief in the form of status quo may be granted. He has cited the provisions of G.R. dated 09-04-2018. Learned Advocate for the applicant has argued that counseling is mandatory requirement before issuing the transfer orders under the provisions of Maharashtra Regulation of Transfer and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act ("Transfer Act" for short) and as per the G.R. issued by the General Administration Department dated 09-04-2018. Applicant submits that as choices for places of posting has not

been taken from the applicant, this technical deficiency in passing transfer order is bad in law.

3. Learned Advocate for the applicant also states that the applicant has been working at District Training Centre, Nandurbar continuously since 05-06-2016 and therefore he is due for transfer. However, there is a technical flaw in the procedure followed by the Civil Services Board that the choices had not been taken before transferring the applicant. The learned Advocate argued that the said procedural deficiency is fatal in nature rendering the said transfer order Invalid. The Learned Advocate further stated that the applicant is due for retirement in next one year and he has old aged parents and family members who require immediate medical care. It is admitted position that Medical Officer (Group-B) as well as in-charge of District Tuberculosis Centre both have responsibilities of touring in their respective areas. It is further submitted by learned Advocate for applicant upon instructions that the applicant has not been relieved following the transfer order dated 09-06-2023 as he is in the court on the first working day after issuance of the impugned order and as

such, no one may have joined in his place by one-sidedly taking over.

4. Today, the applicant is present before the Tribunal during the hearing and claims that he has taken leave of absence from duty. However, the applicant has not produced any evidence towards leave of absence taken by him from his controlling officer. The learned Presenting Officer has submitted that the applicant is in habit of using judicial process to frustrate his transfer orders; however, she has also not appended details of his past postings in chronological order and evidence that the applicant has been, by hook or crook, staying at the same posting for longer period. If for multiple times applicant had been approaching the Tribunal challenging transfer orders and getting the transfer orders stayed, as alleged by the learned P.O., that aspect also has to be taken into consideration to draw any conclusion. Learned P.O. may produce evidence to buttress her claims in this regard.

5. For granting interim relief of maintaining status quo, it is necessary to ascertain whether the reliever has joined on post held by the applicant. As

there is possibility of authorities giving charge to the reliever one-sidedly when anybody transferred remains absent from office upon receiving transfer order, which may complicate the issue of payment of salary to the applicant or to the reliever.

6. **In view of above, the status quo as on today afternoon, be maintained till 19-06-2023.** By that time, learned P.O. may seek instructions and get the necessary details and brief reply be filed. In case, the reliever has already joined in place of the applicant then the applicant should comply with the transfer order subject to outcome of this application. It is being clarified that interim relief granted may be extended only after considering the facts on record instead of extending it mechanically because of the reason of the applicant seeking adjournment.

7. Issue notices to the respondents, returnable on 19.06.2023.

8. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at once and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.

9. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on respondent/s intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of the case. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

10. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.

11. The service may be done by hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgment be obtained and produced along with affidavit of Compliance in the Registry before due date. Applicant is directed to file affidavit of compliance and notice.
