Transfer Act itself facilitating the retention of such employees whose retirement is within one year from the date of transfer, to be retained at the station at which they are presently posted till their retirement. Learned Counsel further submitted that wife of the applicant is suffering from Cancer and this is another weighing ground according to the learned Counsel to challenge the impugned order. Learned Counsel in the circumstances has prayed for staying effect and operation of the impugned order till decision of the O.A.

4. Shri Bhumkar, learned P.O. appearing for the respondent nos.1 to 3 submitted that the applicant has already been relieved from his existing post and the charge has been handed over to respondent no.4. It is further contended that the applicant has been transferred by invoking powers under section 4(4)(ii) and 6 of the Transfer Act. Learned P.O. submitted that presently there are no instructions so as to make any submissions as to which were the circumstances which the exceptional for

respondents have transferred the applicant from Latur to Udgir. Learned P.O. submitted that

considering all the above circumstances, no case is made out for grant of interim relief. Learned P.O. prays for 2 weeks' time to file affidavit in reply.

- 5. I have duly considered the submissions advanced on behalf of the applicant as well as the learned P.O. Section 4(4)(ii) of the Transfer Act reads as under:
 - "4. (4) The transfers of Government servants shall ordinarily be made only once in a year in the month of April or May:

Provided that, transfer may be made any time in the year in the circumstances as specified below, namely:—

- (i)
- (ii) where the competent authority is satisfied that the transfer is essential due to exceptional circumstances or special reasons, after recording the same in writing and with the prior approval of the next higher authority."
- 6. It need not be stated that in the order of transfer respondents are not expected to elaborate the reasons or circumstances for transfer of an

employee. Such circumstances can be brought on record through affidavit of the respondents.

As such, when the transfer has been effected by invoking powers under section 4(4)(ii) it would be unjust and improper to pass any order unless an opportunity is given to the respondents to bring on record such circumstances.

- 7. On this, learned Counsel for the applicant submitted that in the present matter the respondents be directed to file affidavit in reply placing all necessary documents along with it by copy of the giving advance same to Submission so made by the learned Counsel is worth considering.
- 8. For the reasons stated above, following order is passed:

2. The applicant had applied for the post of Town from Group-A in pursuance of the Planner advertisement published by the Maharashtra Public Service Commission (in short 'MPSC') 28.01.2022. Total 18 posts were advertised. Out of which one post was reserved for a candidate falling in the category of EWS (Female). The applicant claims to be falling in the said category. It is the case of the applicant that she possesses the educational qualification as prescribed in advertisement for the advertised post and also bears experience as prescribed in the advertisement. It is her further case that she has received 106 marks in the written examination. It is the grievance of the applicant that the respondent No. 5, who has been recommended by the MPSC for the said post

reserved for EWS (Female) did not possess required experience. It is further argued that despite the fact as aforesaid, the MPSC has recommended the name of respondent No. 5, whereas only eligible candidate to be recommended is the present applicant. Learned counsel submitted that the applicant has placed on record all the documents showing that the experience of respondent No. 5 could not have been considered for the advertised post and consequently could not be recommended for appointment on the said post. It is further submitted that the applicant who is working as Planning Assistant and having liable requisite experience alone was to be recommended for the said post by the MPSC. Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that appointment orders may be issued at any time hereinafter. In the circumstances he prayed for the direction against the respondent Nos. 1 and 2 to keep the post reserved for EWS (Female) candidate vacant and not to issue order of appointment in favour of respondent No. 5 till decision of the present Original Application.

3. Shri I.S. Thorat, learned Presenting Officer has sought time to file affidavit in reply. Learned P.O.

submitted that for want of instructions he is unable to make any statement as about the correctness of the fact stated in the O.A. or in the documents filed on record. Learned P.O. in the circumstances has prayed for considering the request for time to file affidavit in reply by the respondents.

- 4. I have duly considered the submissions made on behalf of the applicant, as well as, respondents. The documents on record prima-facie show that the applicant is possessing required educational as well as, requisite qualification, experience prescribed in the advertisement. As has been alleged by the applicant, respondent No. 5 does not possess such experience and in spite of that, her name has been recommended by the MPSC. Learned P.O. has expressed his inability to make any statement either in favour or oppose of the applicant.
- 5. It is, however, the apprehension of the applicant that though the respondent No. 5 is not eligible for appointment, he is likely to be appointed on the said post. According to the learned counsel,

the applicant is the only candidate eligible to be recommended for the post. It is the further contention of the applicant that since the applicant has prima-facie showed that respondent No. 5 does not possess requisite experience interim direction needs to be issued for keeping one post vacant till decision of the present Original Application. Admittedly there is no reply by MPSC or respondent No. 5. The learned P.O. has sought time to file affidavit in reply, wherein the reasons may be brought on record in respect of the contentions raised in the present Original Application. At this juncture though there is prima-facie substance in the contentions raised by the applicant, unless the affidavit in reply is received from the MPSC, as well as, respondent No. 5, it would be unjust to reach to any conclusion as about the experience respondent No. 5. In the circumstances, I deem it appropriate to pass the following order:-

ORDER

Issue notices to respondents, returnable on 10.08.2023. In the meanwhile, if as recommended by MPSC the respondent No. 5 is issued with an

appointment order, the same shall be subject to outcome of the present Original Application.

- (ii) Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at once and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
- (iii) Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on respondent/s intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of the case. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
- (iv) This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
- (v) The service may be done by hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgment be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry before due date. Applicant is directed to file affidavit of compliance and notice.

- (vii) Steno copy and Hamdast is allowed to both parties.
