2. The Applicant has challenged the communication dated 26.07.2021 whereby request of the Applicant to substitute the name of her son [Applicant No.2] is rejected on the ground that the name of Applicant No.1 is already in waiting list at Serial No.36.

3. Admittedly, after the death of deceased Government servant Ramesh B. Khude, his wife Smt. Mangal R. Khude [Applicant No.1] applied for compassionate appointment and her name was accordingly enrolled in waiting list. Not only that, the Respondent issued communication dated 07.04.2021 (correct date 07.04.2022) calling upon the Applicant that one post is vacant, and therefore, she should remain present along with necessary document for verification on 11.04.2022. However, instead of complying communication dated 07.04.2021, the Applicants have filed the present O.A. and sought direction to the Respondent to substitute the name of Applicant No.2 in place of Applicant No.1.

4. Thus, this is not a case where the name of mother is deleted from waiting list on account of age bar, in which situation, substitution may be permissible. Here is the case, Applicant No.1 is already offered employment, but she seems to be not ready to accept the same.

5. In view of above, prima-facie, the O.A. is not maintainable.

6. The learned Advocate for the Applicant requested for one week time to take instructions from the client to take necessary steps.




